George Colligan, a New York-based jazz pianist, organist, trumpeter, drummer, composer, bandleader – and most recently, a member of the Portland State University music faculty, will make his Portland debut concert on Tuesday, Dec. 13, at 8 p.m. at the Mission Theater, 1624 N.W. Glisan St.

An elite session performer and sideman in the New York area during the late 1990s, Colligan appeared on nearly 100 CDs. He recently toured with artists such as Cassandra Wilson, Miguel Zenón, Don Byron, Gary Bartz, Jack DeJohnette, Michael Becker and Ravi Coltrane.

He will be performing with guitarist Dan Balmer, bassist Eric Gruber, drummer Todd Strait, and special guest pianist Kerry Politzer.

Tickets are \$15 in advance and on the day of the show.
