Shots Fired at PCC Cascade

Drive-by shooting aimed at campus parking

Bullets were fired in a drive by shooting last Thursday at the Portland Community College Cascade Campus in north Portland. The gunfire struck two parked vehicles and one woman's car

as she was trying to exit a campus parking lot. There were no injuries.

Reports indicated that a dark colored American sedan drove out of the parking lot on North Albina and stopped in the street. At 5:15 p.m., two African-American males, armed with handguns, got out of the vehicle and fired in the direction of the parking lot.

A PCC public safety officer heard the gunfire and called the Portland Police. Upon arrival, officers determined that the suspects had fled the


area and the campus was no longer in immediate danger.

Gang officers investigated the shooting. An hour later at 6:21 p.m., shots were fired near North Commercial and Mason, about a mile away. Witnesses reported hearing as many as 12 shots fired and seeing a white SUV and a red sedan at the scene. No one was hit.

It is unknown whether the two incidents are related.

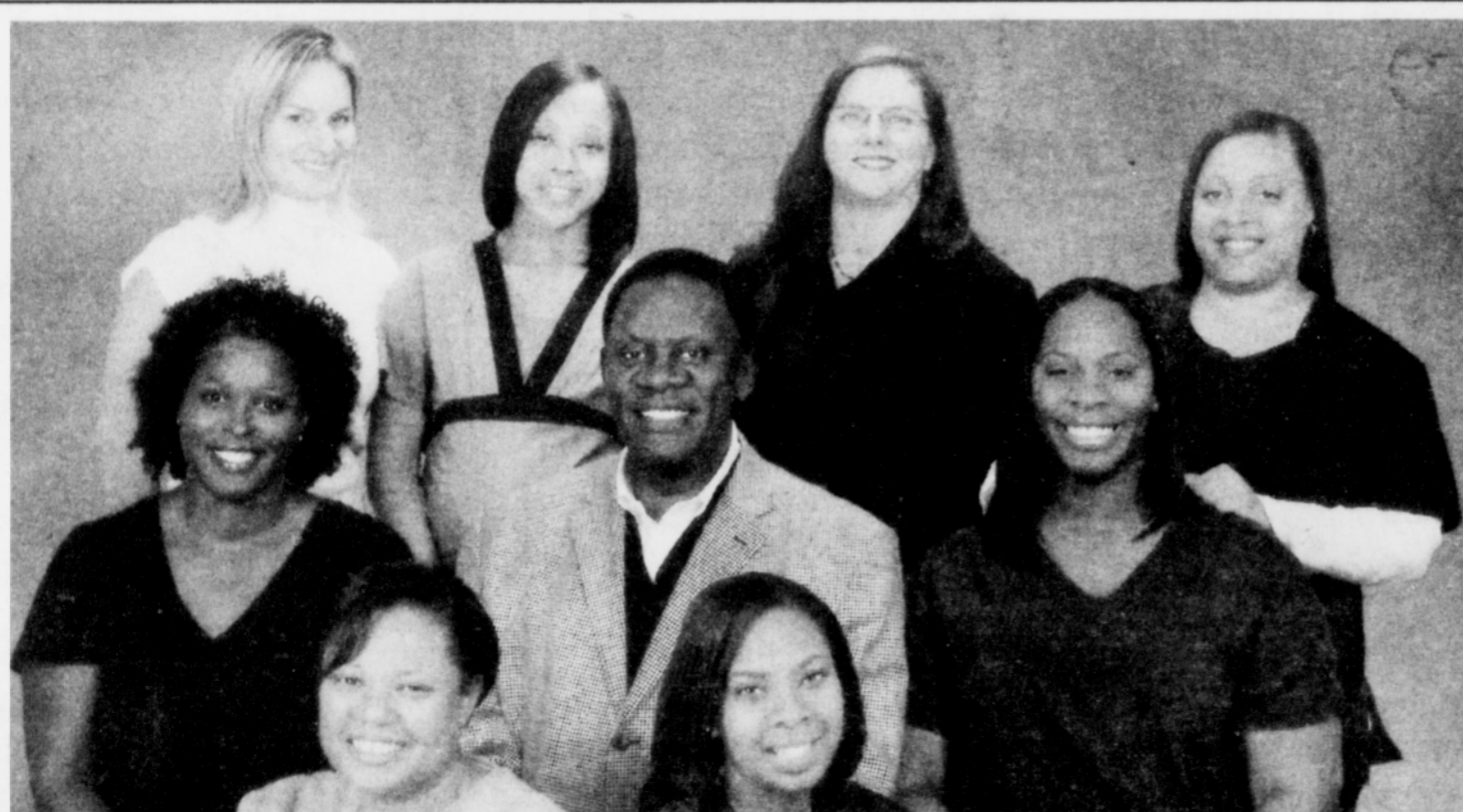

Part 14. Scoliosis Exam: The most important test your kids will take all year.

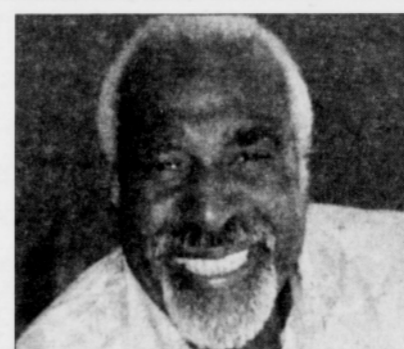
