community who want to increase safety within their neighborhoods.

This one was requested by Portland Community College, she said.

White posed as the human decoy and walked several times across the crosswalk to make sure everyone using the street was being cooperative.

"We just want people to know about the traffic laws," she said.

Officer Brian Sweeney with the traffic division agreed.

"We want to educate people," he

said, as he stood inside a bus shelter, examining the traffic on the streets. "This particular location is important because of all the students crossing."

The crosswalk, which is positioned in front of Portland Community College Cascade Campus, the North Portland Library and Jefferson High School, is a high traffic area for pedestrians, as well as cars, bikes, and skateboards.

"It's about safety and vulnerable road users," he said. "Everyone needs to share the road."

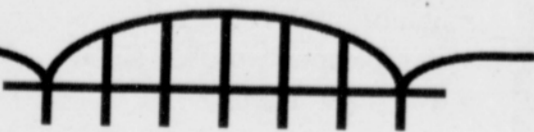
