Pride & Passion -- The Central Library downtown hosts **Pride & Passion: The African-American Baseball Experience**, a traveling exhibition that examines the challenges faced by black baseball players as they sought equal opportunities in their sport beginning in the post-Civil War era until Jackie Robinson broke the color barrier in 1947. The exhibit will be on display until Jan. 22.



Christmas Festival of Lights -- The Grotto's Christmas Festival of Lights (Northeast 85th and Sandy) features five indoor concerts each evening. Nearly one million lights are spectacularly presented about The Grotto's pristine gardens. The festival continues through Friday, Nov. 30 from 5 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. Admission is \$8 for adults and \$4 for children.
