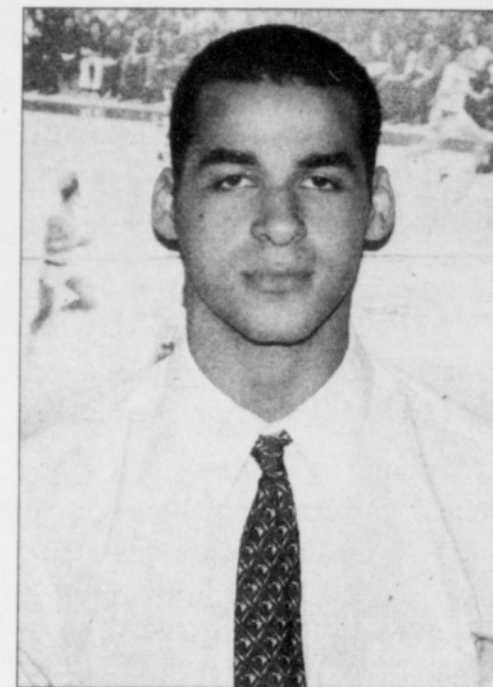

Two Portland area students are making their mark on the Saint Michael's College Men's Basketball program at Colchester, Vt.

Sophomore Mike Holton Jr. and freshman Dom Ditlefsen both played at Sunset High School in Beaverton.

Holton, the son of former Portland Trail Blazer Michael Holton,

has 587 points through 37 career games. He is averaging 16.1 points this year, more than the 15.8 he averaged last year while setting the St. Michael's rookie scoring record.

Ditlefsen was all-state in both basketball and football as a prep star in Oregon.



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
