- Graduated from Booker T. Washington High School and was admitted to Morehouse College at age 15.

1948

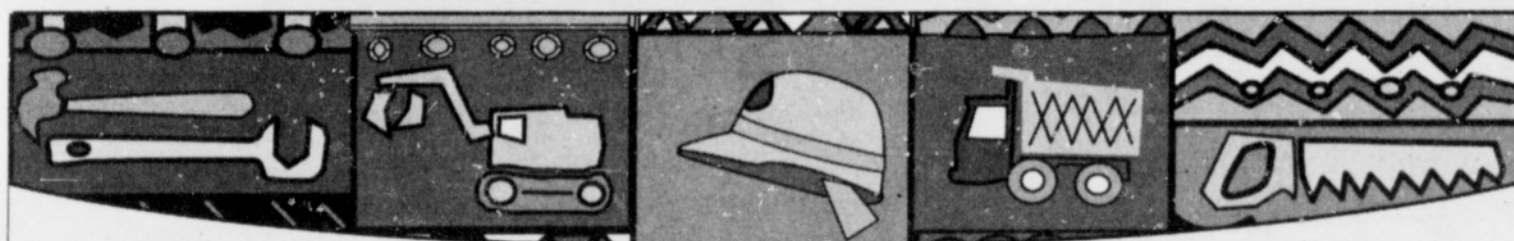
- Graduates from Morehouse College and enters Crozer Theological Seminary.
- Ordained to the Baptist ministry at age 19.

1951

- Enters Boston University for graduate studies.

1953

- Marries Coretta Scott (pictured with King below) and settles in Montgomery, Ala.
