To give local youth the opportunity for their voice to be heard, the African Methodist Episcopal Zion churches in Portland and Vancouver are hosting a teen summit and young adult assembly known as 'Teens 'N' Jeans.'

The convocation-style event will take place on Saturday, Jan. 14 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Clark Public Utilities Building, 1200 Fort Vancouver Way in Vancouver.

The summit is geared for youth, ages 13 to 23, to learn and discuss the issues affecting young people today, including gang violence, health and wellness, and

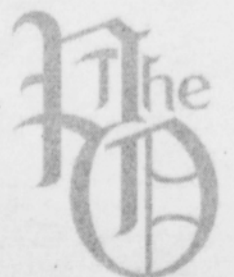
