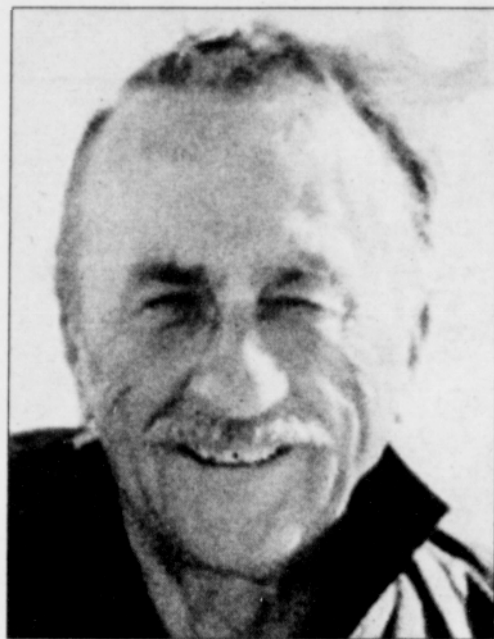


In Loving Memory



John H. Wolf

A memorial service will be held for John H. Wolf on Sunday, Jan. 29 at 5 p.m. in the chapel at Skyline Memorial Gardens.

John passed away on Friday, Jan. 20, 2012 in Portland, at age 91. He was born Sept. 26, 1920, to Henry A. and Rose (Spencer) Wolf in Portland, the youngest of four children. At a very young age he lost both of his parents. He grew up during the depression. This would shape the rest of his life as a devoted family man and tenacious worker.

He attended Chapman Elementary School and Roosevelt High School, graduating in the class of 1940. While in the Navy aboard the U.S.S. Anderson #411 during World War II, he met Dorothy Stewart, of Wellington, New Zealand. They married in 1947. He later went on to marry Katherine Swenson in 1969.

John started several businesses, including Cedar West Carpets, where he and his son, Daryl, worked together. He was preceded in death by his son, Daryl; his stepdaughter, Kathy Ling; and his first wife, Dorothy.

He is survived by his daughters, Sherrie Wolf and Kim Wolf; stepdaughters, Terry Ling and Sandra Normoyle; five granddaughters and

four great-grandchildren.

John will be remembered as a man who genuinely cared for other people and taking care of his family. In lieu of flowers, contributions may be made in his name to Our House of Portland.
