Indigenous Voices

Lillian Pitt, a Native American artist from the Big River (Columbia River) region of the Pacific Northwest, will share stories about her ongoing journey in life during an Indigenous Voices lecture on Friday, Feb. 3 at 7 p.m. in the PSU Native American Student and Community Center, 710 S.W. Jackson St.

Born on the Warm Springs Reservation, Pitt is a descendent of Wasco, Yakama, and Warm Springs people.

She is one of the most highly regarded Native American artists in the Pacific Northwest. Her works are all aimed at giving voice to her people.

"Everything I do, regardless of the medium, is directly related to honoring my ancestors and giving voice to the people, the environment and the animals," Pitt said. "It's all about maintaining a link with tradition, and about honoring the many contributions my ancestors have made to this world."
