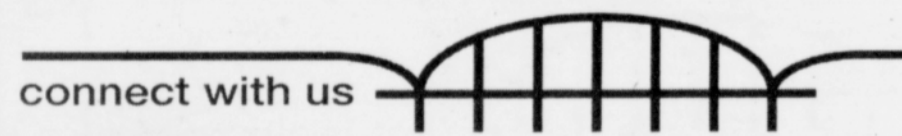
**CITY OF PORTLAND SEEKS HEARINGS OFFICER FOR CONTRACT WORK**

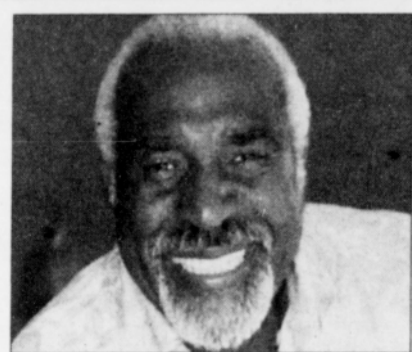

# Occupy Protest Turns Violent

Portland police arrested 10 people from an estimated 175 protesters who marched Monday night in the vicinity of Colonel Summers Park at Southeast 20th and Belmont, in what was billed as a demonstration to support Occupy Oakland.

Police say some demonstrators broke a glass door at a restaurant, threw garbage and vandalized several cars.

Lt. Robert King said those arrested are accused of disorderly conduct and interfering with officers. They included a 15-year-old boy.

Dozens of officers responded at the peak of the demonstration.

Several protesters said they were upset about the damage caused by a small faction in the crowd.

More than 400 people were arrested on Jan. 28 in Oakland, Calif., when a midday march escalated into a clash between some rock-throwing protesters and police who responded with tear gas.
