A civil rights activist and a professor of humanities will be visiting Lewis and Clark College in southwest Portland this month for two lecture events for Black History Month, which will ad-

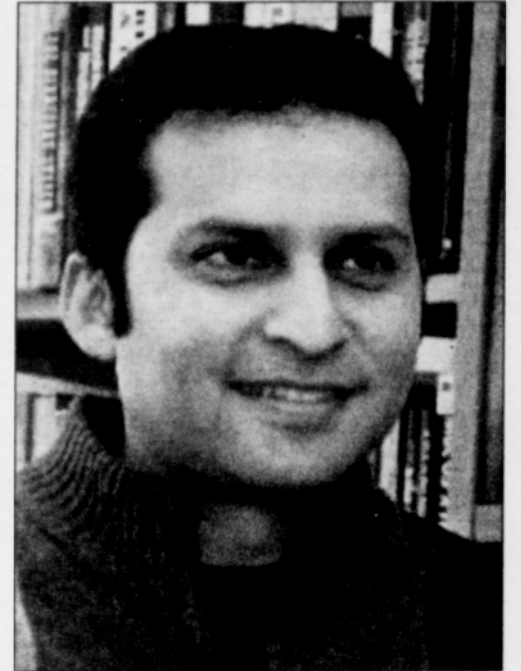
dress topics related to the state of diversity within the country.

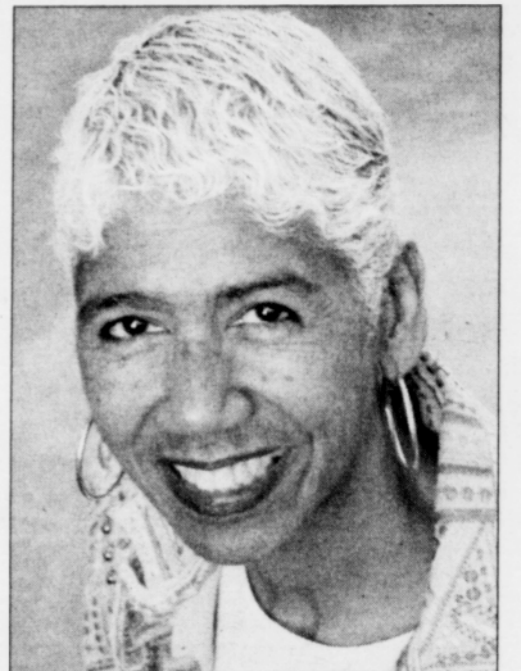
shaping these responses.
