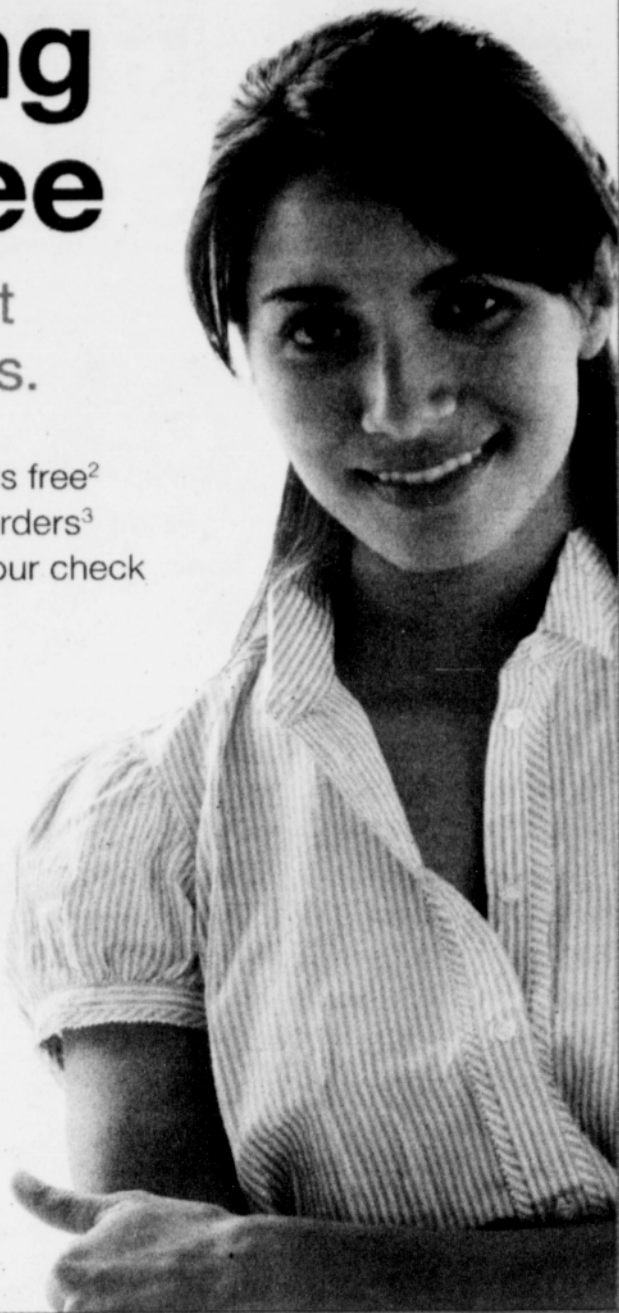

### Cyclist Swims to Rescue

Cyclist Kevin Pratt, who had stopped to take a break at a bench along the Eastbank Esplanade Sunday, jumped into the frigid river to save a drowning man and pulled him to shore. The victim's family, who called Pratt a hero, said their family member had limited mental abilities and apparently thought he could swim to a nearby public dock.

### Housing Crisis Help

Casting himself as a president in charge of the recovery, President Obama Tuesday unveiled his administration's latest plan to tackle the housing crisis, announcing new mortgage relief for military personnel and homeowners with government-insured loans.



### Obama Assails War Talk

President Obama Tuesday accused Republican White House hopefuls of recklessly "beating the drums of war" against Iran for political gain while ignoring the potential human costs of such a conflict. "Some of these folks have a lot of bluster and

a lot of big talk," he said scornfully at a White House press conference.
