Hilton "Buzz" Ward, 67, passed away Monday April 16, 2012 at home in Portland.

He was born Nov. 7, 1944 in Cisco, Texas. His parents were Hilton Ward I and Vera Elizabeth Patterson.

He attended Paul Lawrence Dunbar High School in Ft. Worth, Texas, where he participated in marching, stage, and jazz bands. He also loved to dance.
