Learning to Live 'Green'

Sustainable practices to reduce waste and protect the environment were showcased in Vancouver for Earth Day.

Clark County Environmental Services, in cooperation with community partners, sponsored the a half-day Do It Yourself fair on Saturday to teach residents how to better connect with their environment and save money by the way they care for their yards and clean their homes.

"We want people to repair things rather than throw them away when they can still be very useful," said Sally Fisher, sustainability specialist.

The fair included workshops about rain barrels, rain gardens, bike basics, vegetable gardening, computer maintenance, green cleaning, and basic plumbing and wiring. The tips included lessons in tree planting and care, weed control, composting, weatherization, screen and screen door repair and how to size your lawn.

Free Composting Workshops

For tips on how to recycle kitchen scraps and yard wastes into compost for successful gardens this spring, local residents can join several composting workshops scheduled in the coming months in Vancouver.

Classes include an introduction to composting science, and a visit to a composting demonstration site. A course in vermi composting will cover the basics of using red worms to turn kitchen food scraps into black gold for the garden.
