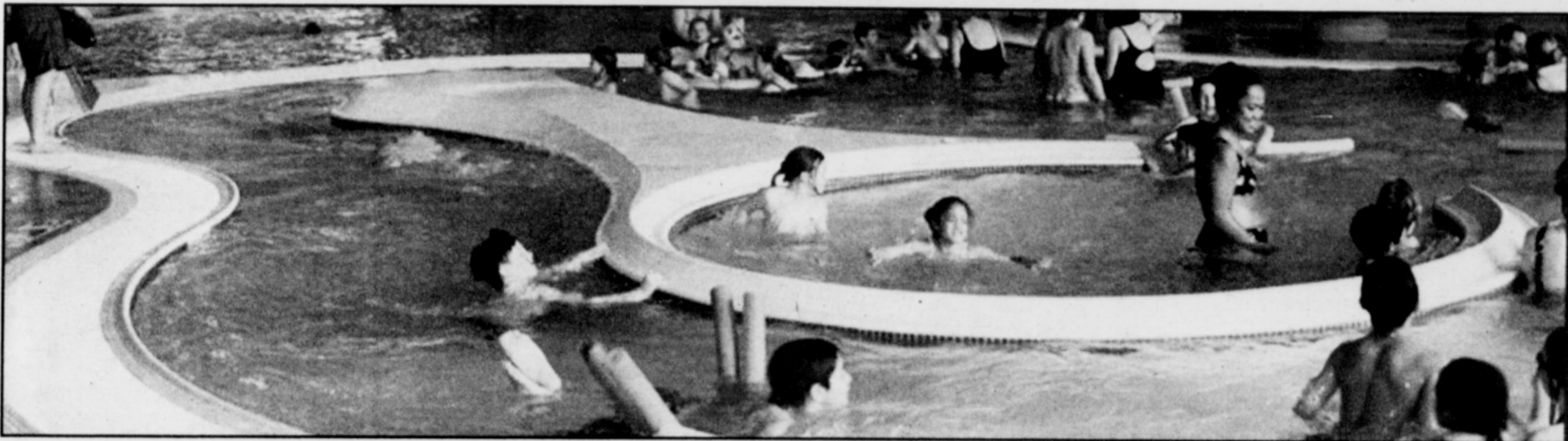


SUMMER FUN GUIDE

Water Safety Fun Day

Portland Parks and Recreation is offering a fun opportunity to learn more about how to stay safe in and around the water.

According to the Centers for Disease Control, drowning is a leading cause of accidental death for young children ages 1-4, and the fifth leading reason for accidental death for people of all ages.

On Friday, May 18, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., the Mt. Scott Community Center, 5530 S.E. 72nd Ave., will host its annual Water Safety Fun Day.

You can enjoy an evening of swimming with fun activities, games and prizes, as well as water safety information. There will also be a free drawing for lifejackets.

All of Portland's Parks and Recreation pools offer top-of-the-line swimming instruction, water safety tips, plus open swims, water slides, play structures, special events such as Dive-In Movies (watch the screen while floating in the water!) and other family fun.

Free Youth Fishing Clinic

The Hood River Ranger District of the Mount Hood National Forest will be hosting its annual Free Youth Fishing Clinic on Saturday, May 19, from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Middle Fork Irrigation Pond on Laurance Lake Road in Parkdale.

Participants will enjoy casting competitions, a contest for the largest fish, and other games with prizes and refreshments donated by supporting local businesses. Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult and are encouraged to bring fishing gear.
