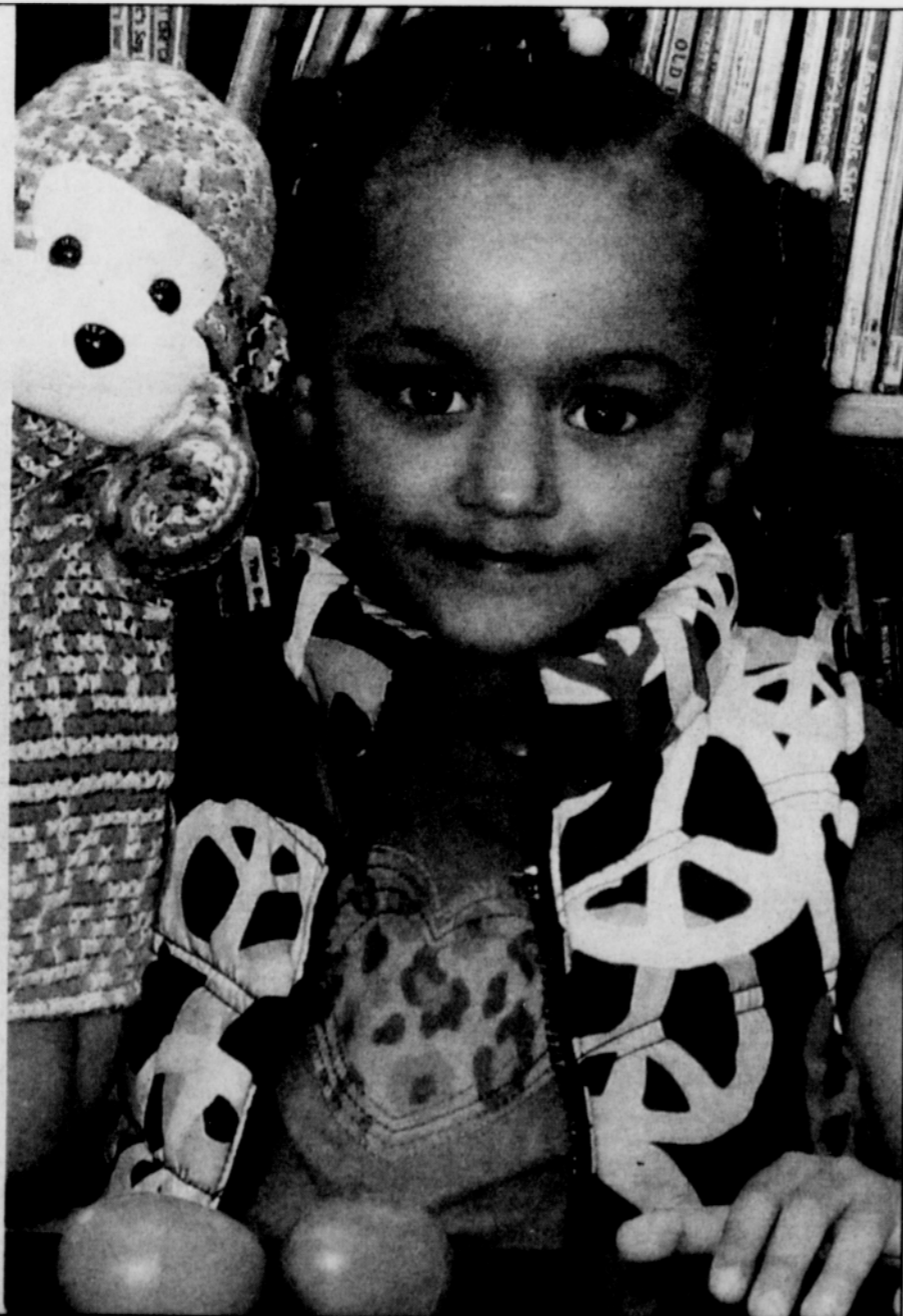
## Journey to the Arctic
