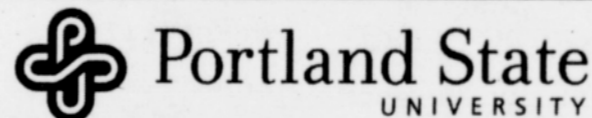

diagnose and treat a variety of minor health conditions, including colds, skin issues, infections and low back pain. The clinic also offers wellness services.

Dr. Ray Costantini, regional medical director for Providence Health eXpress, said the clinic started seeing patients a week earlier.

"By midweek, we have seen about two dozen patients with a wide variety of complaints, and we have had very positive feedback about their experiences with the video visit. One employee said that without this service, he would have to take a half-day off to get his issue resolved," Costantini said.

The service is available to all Oregon state employees living or working in Salem who are enrolled in a PEBB medical plan, either through Providence Health Plan or Kaiser Permanente.

continues a pattern from the past few years.

Cascade enrollment grew by 8.5 percent in overall headcount to a spring term total of 12,202 students and 5.4 percent in credit enrollment to a total of 2,089 FTE.

The Rock Creek Campus in northwest Portland saw headcount grow by 5.3 percent for a total of 13,378 students and the number of credit students rose by 3.3 percent or 2,461 FTE.

Sylvania Campus in southeast Portland, the biggest PCC campus, inched up by 3.2-percent in total student enrollment of 17,307 students and 2.7 percent in FTE.

The Southeast Center/Extended Learning Campus saw core credit enrollment increase by 2.1 percent (1,003 FTE).

PCC is the largest post-secondary institution in Oregon and 19th largest in the nation, serving approximately 92,537 full- and part-time students.
