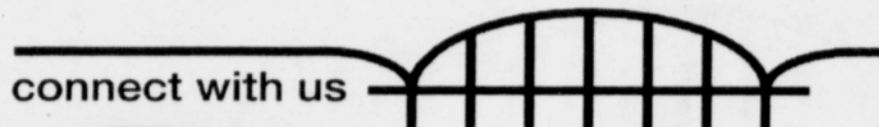

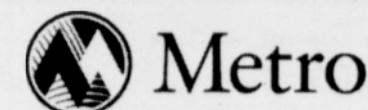

The New Market Annex is a historic 6-story building constructed in 1889 as a support space for the once adjacent New Market Theatre. The New Market Annex now serves as the administrative headquarters for Home Forward. The project consists of building envelope restoration to the existing masonry and wood windows. Work includes seismic upgrades to the building exterior and to the interior fire sprinkler system.
