Excavating Like Archaeologists

Fort Vancouver offers summer program

Do you dig Fort Vancouver? Then visit Fort Vancouver National Historic Site to excavate like a real archaeologist!

During Kids Digs, youth aged 8-12 are introduced to archaeology by participating in a mock dig, mapping their artifact finds, and filling out site forms. As youth excavate and screen with the help of park staff and volunteers, the participants discover how we learn from archaeology, and why we should preserve these pieces of our past.

Youth participating in the program learn how archaeologists excavate, as well as what role the science of archaeology has in understanding the past.

At the end of the sessions, participants get to interpret their excavation and tell us what they learned about what happened in the past based on the units they excavated.

Fort entrance fees of \$3 apply to adults 16 years and older, but the program is free for youth. Kids Digs are limited to 20 youth. The program runs from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on the following Saturdays: July 28, Aug. 4, Aug. 18, Aug. 25, and Sept. 1.

This Saturday, visitors will also be able to visit real archaeologists who are digging in the field at the South Vancouver Barracks, discovering about life in the eras of the Hudson's Bay Company and U.S. Army.
