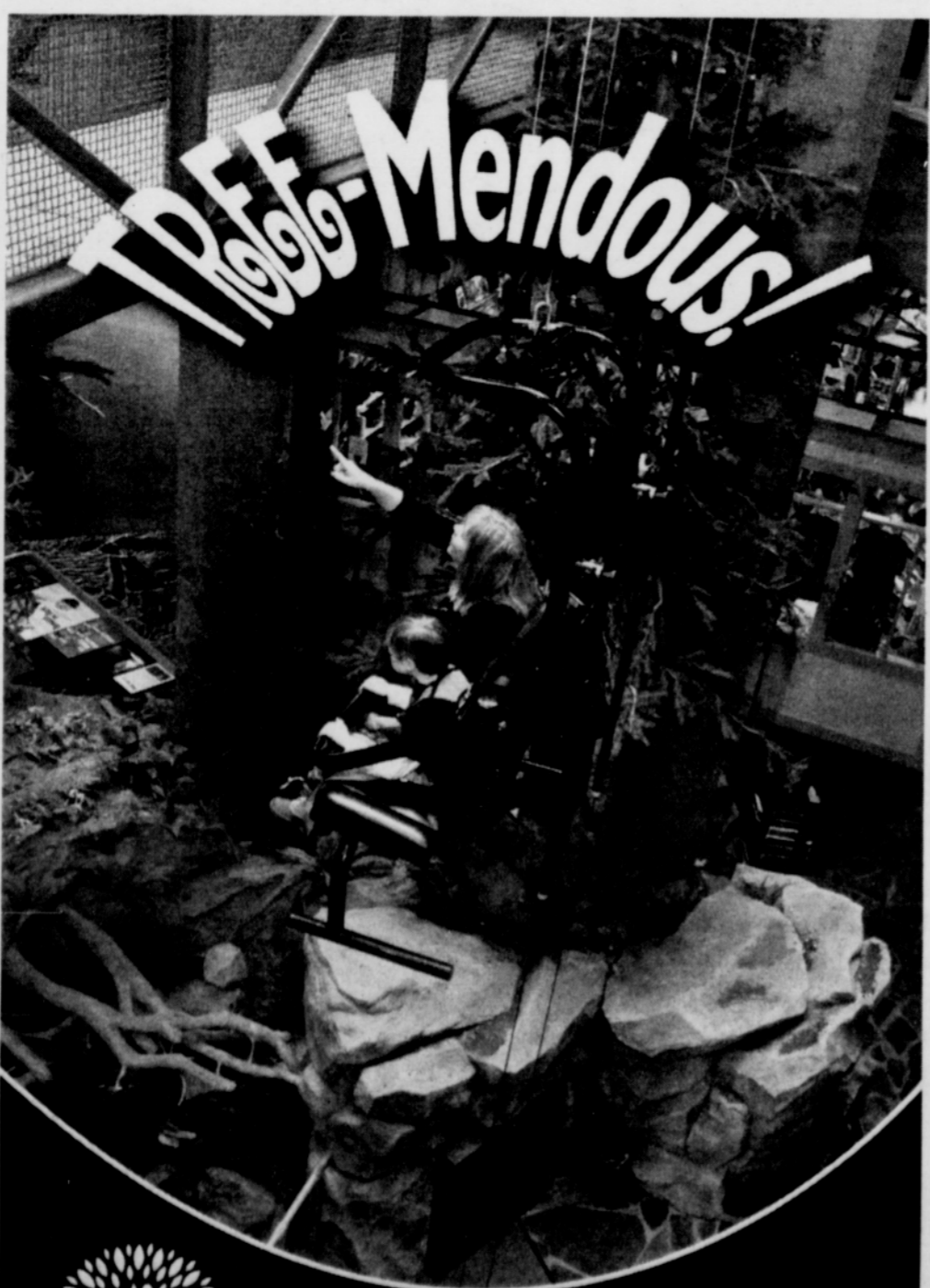

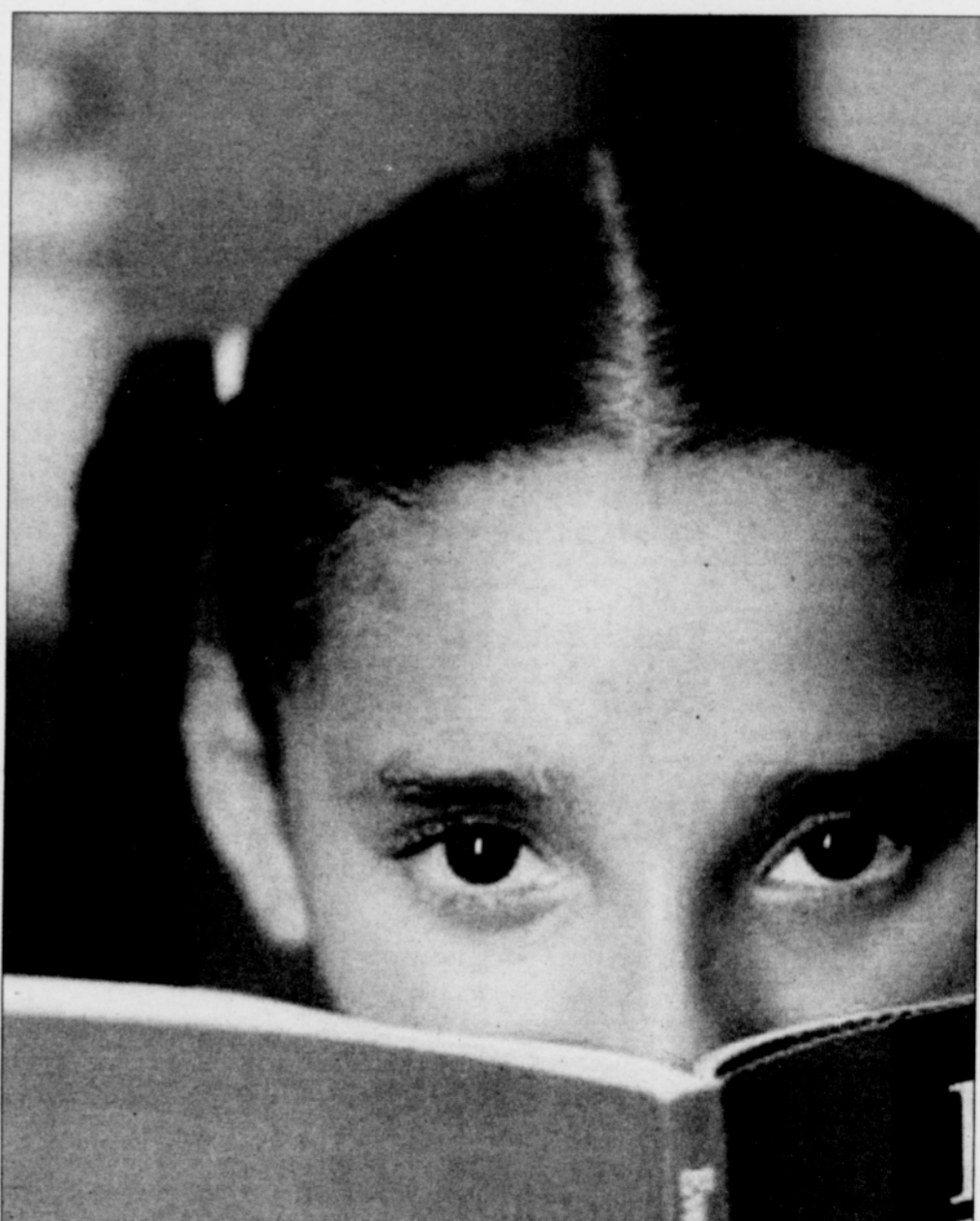

Children are invited to have fun and improve their literacy skills through a Summer Reading program at the Multnomah County Library.

Summer Reading Fun

The Multnomah County Library aims to help kids improve upon their literacy skills during the summer months, and have fun while they're at it. track their progress on gameboards and compete to earn books, free passes, restaurant coupons and other prizes.

The 100th year of Summer Reading launched in July and runs through August. Many events for children of all ages are being offered at the various branch libraries.

The program is open to kids of all ages, from birth to high school students entering grade 12. Anyone who has not signed up may do so at any neighborhood library. Participants can

Discount Tickets -- Local low-income families and individuals can purchase \$5 tickets to classical musical performances in Portland as part of a unique program called Music for All. Participating organizations include the Oregon Symphony, Portland Opera, Oregon Ballet Theater, Chamber Music Northwest, Portland Youth Philharmonic, Portland Baroque Orchestra, Friends of Chamber Music, Portland Chamber Orchestra, Portland Piano International, Portland Symphonic Choir, Cappella Romana and Portland Vocal Consort.

Discount Admission -- OMSI visitors pay only \$2 per person for general admission on the first Sunday of each month as well as discounted admission of \$5 to the Planetarium, OMIMAX Theater and USS Blueback submarine.
