Japanese Buddhist Festival

The Oregon Buddhist Temple, 3720 S.E. 34th Ave., will host Obonfest on Saturday, Aug. 4 from 3 p.m. to 9 a.m. Attendance is free of charge and everyone is welcome.

The annual event will feature Obon dance, taiko performances, a Portland Shotokan Karate Do demonstration, children's activities, and talks on Jodo Shinshu Buddhism.

Attendees will also find Japanese foods for purchase including yakisoba, yakiniku, yakitori, chirashi sushi, Spam musubi, manju, and shave ice. The festival will have a beer and sake garden, and non-alcoholic beverages will be for sale as well.

Japanese goods and services will include Oshie art with chiyogami paper, Shiatsu massage, pottery, handmade purses, meditation products, books, music, T-shirts and other items. Obonfest is a summertime Japanese festival commemorating one's ancestors. In their honor, lanterns are hung, Obon dance is performed, memorial visits are made, and food is offered at house altars and temples.
