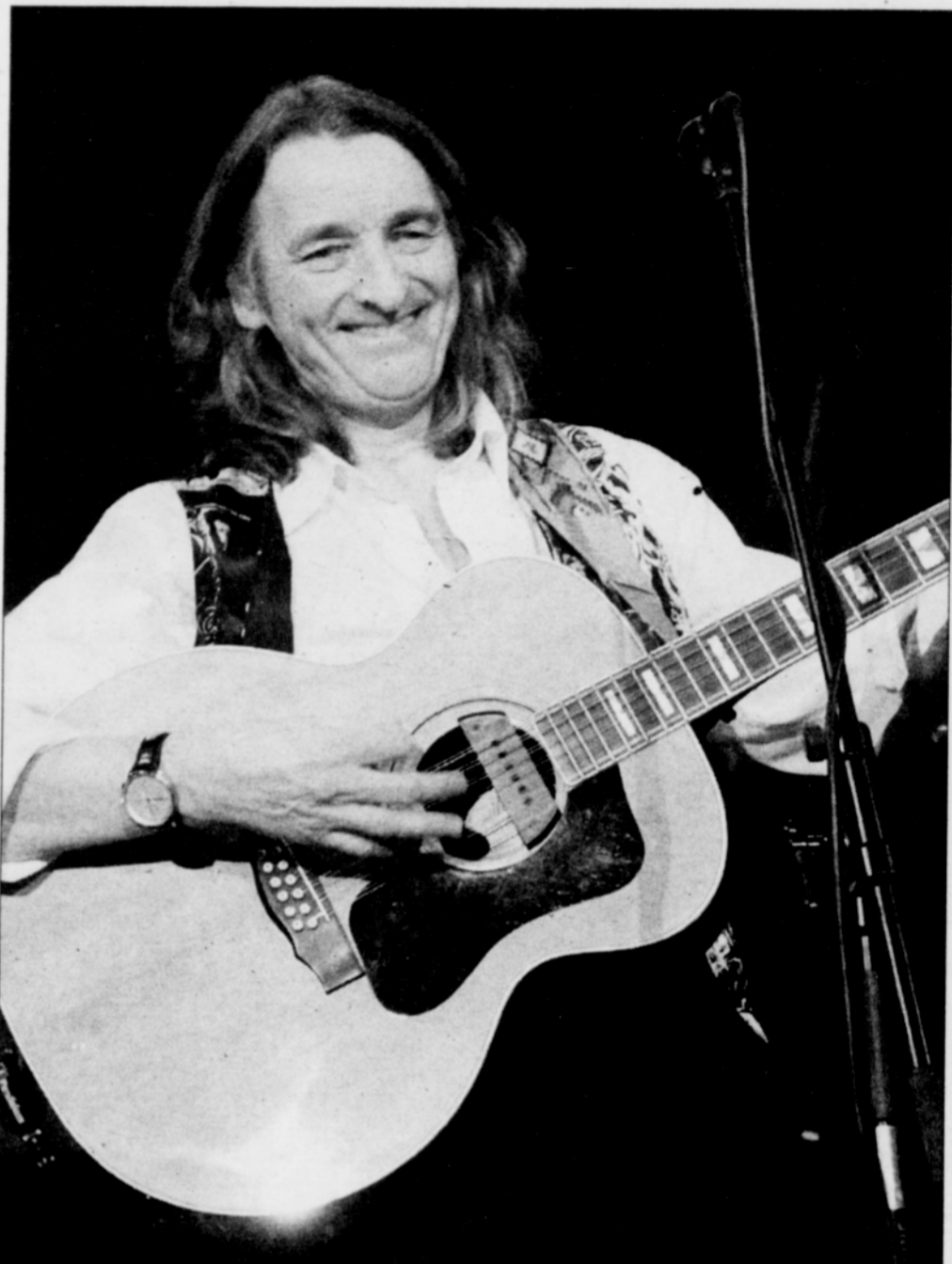

Voice from Supertramp

Hitmaker fronts zoo concert series

In 1979, as the Oregon Zoo prepared to launch its first summer concert series, Supertramp's "Breakfast in America" was enconced at No. 1 on the Billboard album charts, held aloft for six weeks by Top 10 hits like "Take the Long Way Home" and "The Logical Song."

Supertramp, at least the way we knew them then, is no more, but Roger Hodgson, who wrote and sang nearly all the group's best-known songs, is back this year after almost three decades away from the spotlight.

Hodgson brings his "Breakfast in America" tour to town Friday, Aug. 10 as part of the zoo's sum-

mer concert series, presented by Regence BlueCross BlueShield of Oregon with support from U.S. Bank and Toyota.

A multi-instrumentalist and founding member of Supertramp, Hodgson helped the band to widespread success over eight albums through the 1970s and early '80s, producing such memorable hits as "Dreamer," "Give a Little Bit" and "It's Raining Again."

Tickets are \$28 and can be purchased at the zoo during normal operating hours. Tickets can also be purchased (with service charge) at all Ticketmaster ticket centers.
