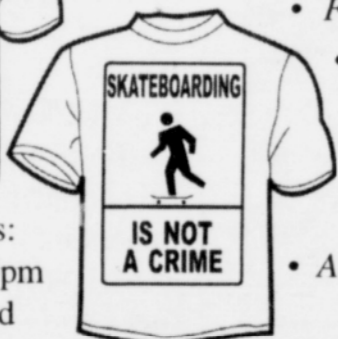

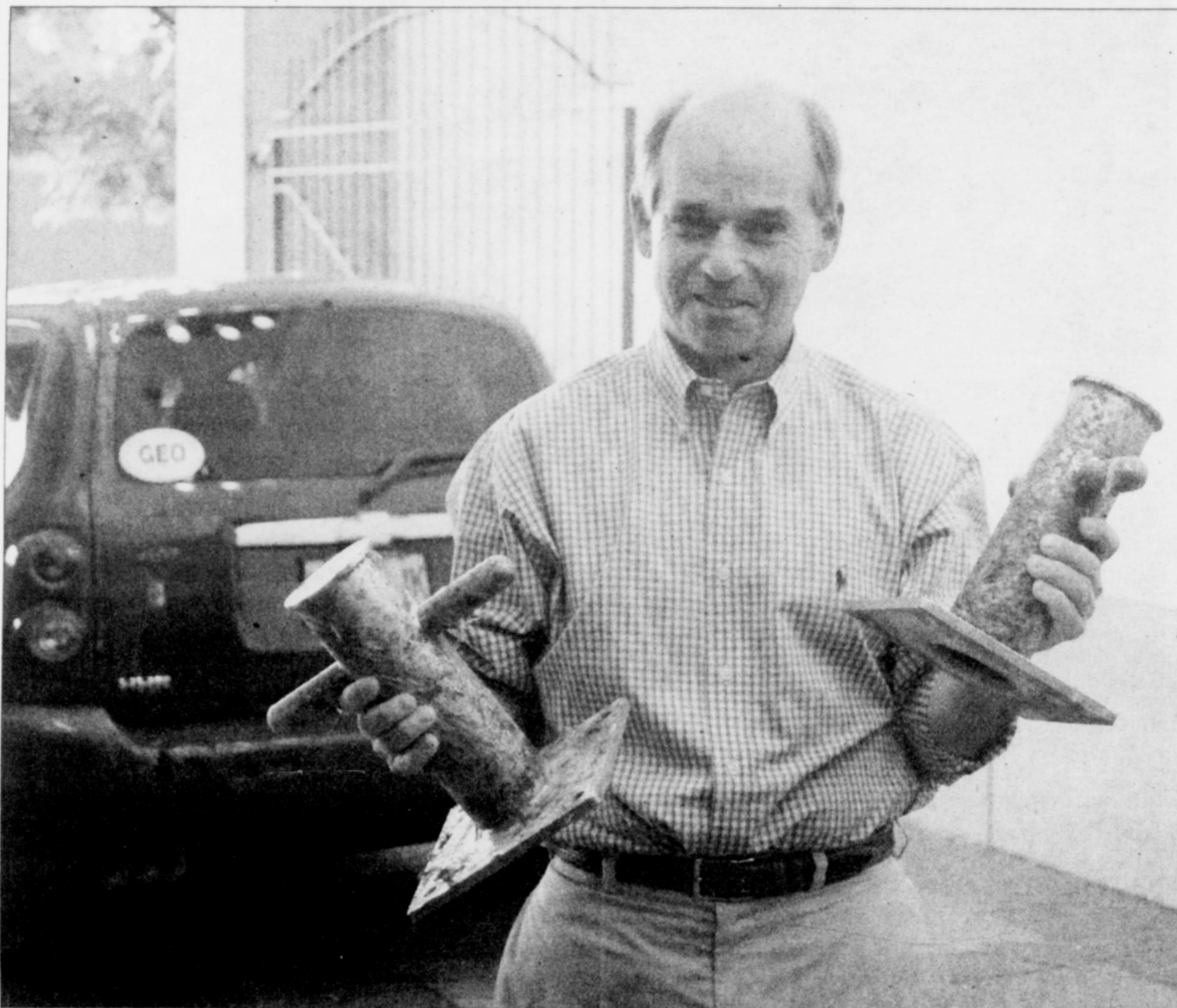

Tsunami Artifacts on Display

Two pieces of the massive 201 ton dock that was washed away from a city on Japan's northeast coast by the devastating March 2011 tsunami and that landed on Oregon's Agate Beach this past June have now arrived at the Oregon Historical Society in Portland.

"When the Oregon Department of Parks and Recreation

began the process of dismantling and removing the dock, I expressed our interest in obtaining a piece for our permanent collection," said Kerry Tymchuk, OHS executive director. "We are proud to be able to apply our unique resources to preserve and protect this fascinating piece of history."

The pieces of the dock that

the Oregon Historical Society received are two metal boat tie offs, each weighing an estimated 20 pounds. They are on display in the "Treasures of the Vault" exhibit at the museum through Dec. 30.

Admission to the museum is \$11, and is free for OHS members and all Multnomah County residents.
