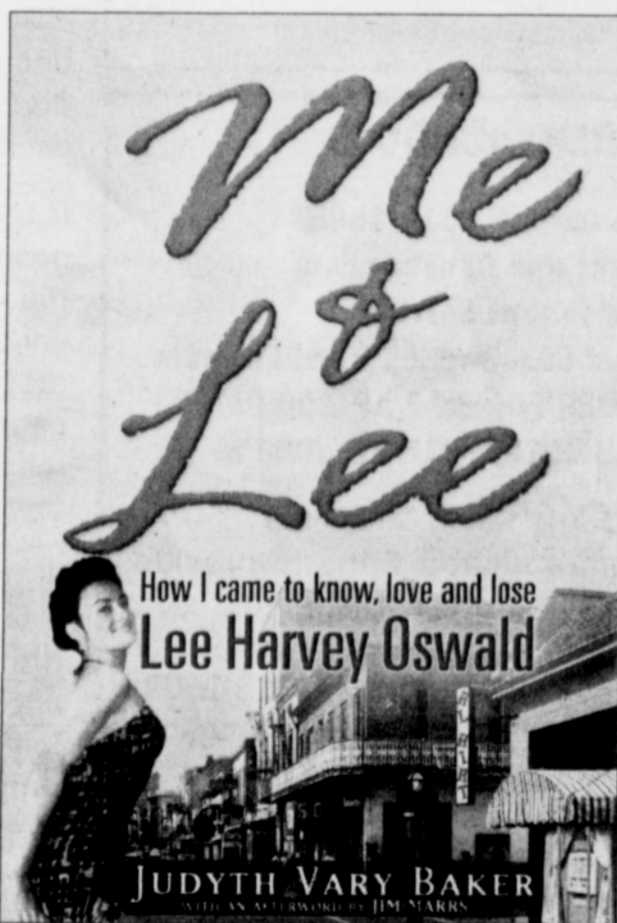

Author Introduces Conspiracy Book Girlfriend to Kennedy's killer says he did not act alone

Judyth Vary Baker, the author of an explosive new book that claims that Lee Harvey Oswald was not President John F. Kennedy's lone killer, will be in Portland for a public presentation on Monday, Nov. 12 at 7:30 p.m. in Room C120 at the Oregon Convention Center.

Baker is a living witness to events that changed America, and knew Lee Harvey Oswald as well as other key players from that fateful day when Kennedy was assassinated in November 1963.

After decades of hiding



her story, she is coming forward to explain how tainted polio vaccines, which showed that cancer could be transferred by injection, spurred a internationally well-known physician to recruit her for a research project that became linked to anti-communist extremists.

The book tells the story of how Lee Harvey Oswald became her constant companion and eventual lover, due to his involvement with this same project which was developing a bio-weapon for use against Cuban leader Fidel Castro.

Former Gov. Jesse Ventura calls Baker's book "stunning" and ranked it among his six favorite conspiracy reads.

Me & Lee: How I came to Know, Love and Lose Lee Harvey Oswald is published by TrineDay Books, headquartered in Eugene and founded by local business owner and musician Kris Millegan.

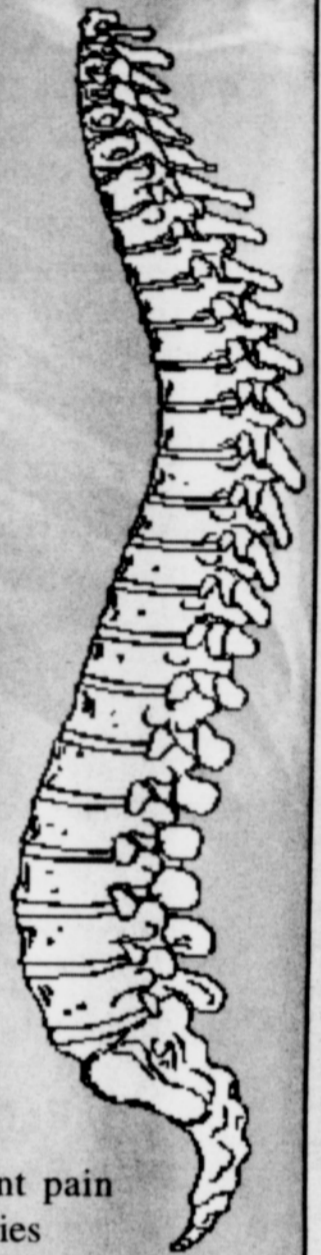
