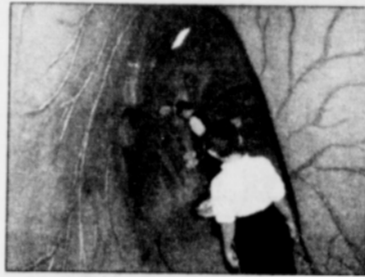
Norman Sylvester Band --

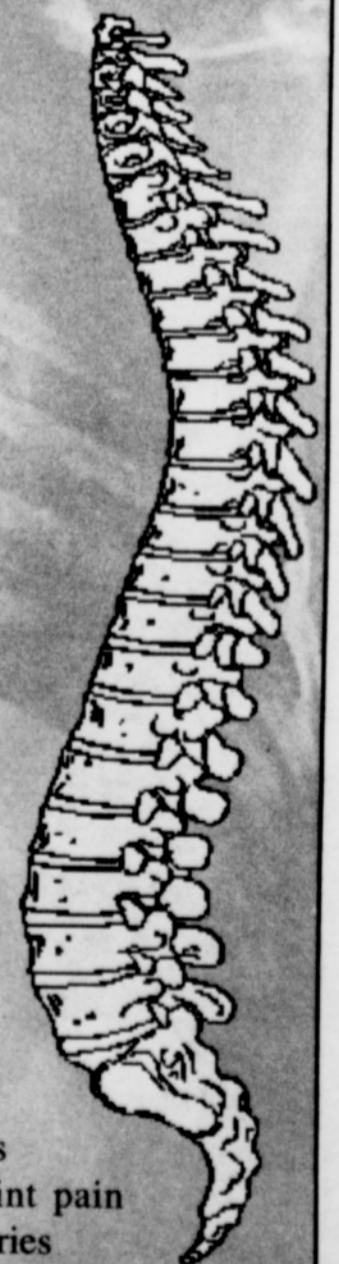
