Strong, who recently published a book dealing with how fatherlessness affects the church, and Ken Canfield, author and television personality, who founded the National Center for Fathering.

Strong emphasizes that all are welcome to join the discussion.

"It doesn't matter if you are black or white or red or yellow—broken families bear the same pain

and we need each other to heal," Strong said.

Due to ongoing troop withdrawals from Iraq and Afghanistan, the group expects another steep surge in service demands next year. The group is trying to raise \$42,000 by the
