## A Step Up for Dental Care

With five dental chairs equipped for full dental services, downtown Portland has its first permanent, safety net dental clinic.

The new Billi Odegaard clinic, located on the third floor of the new Central City Concern building at 33 N.W. Broadway, is expected to serve up to 1,500 clients a year, many of them people who are homeless or among the most vulnerable in our community.

The clinic is the result of a partnership between Multnomah County and Central City Concern. CareOregon provided the equipment. Donations from Providence Partners in Health and the late Portland philanthropist John D. Gray further made this effort possible.

and advocates with listeners across the region.”

Clear Channel Management that urges the station’s owner to bring back progressive talk radio in Portland. The left-leaning line-up also included nationally syndicated talk radio hosts such as Thom Hartmann (who formerly lived in Portland), Randi Rhodes, and Ed Schultz.

“620 KPOJ was a respected and profitable station with dedicated listeners and advertisers,” reads the online petition that people can sign by a quick click of the mouse. “KPOJ’s local programming also played an important role in our community, connecting elected officials

In a joint-statement, Congresswoman Suzanne Bonamici and Congressman Earl Blumenauer released their thoughts on the KPOJ situation, “We are disappointed to learn that the lively conversation in Portland talk radio has lost one of its most interesting and thought-provoking voices. KPOJ was not only a home for progressives, but an important watchdog for government. We encourage Clear Channel to reconsider this decision and revive the progressive talk radio format in the Portland market.”
