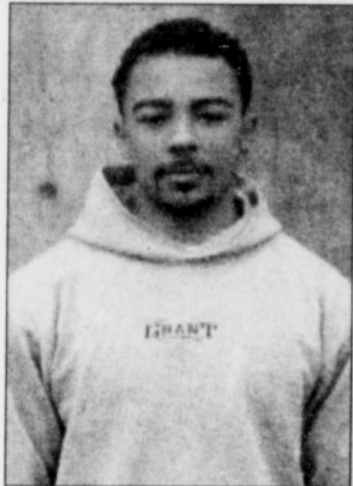


SPORTS
