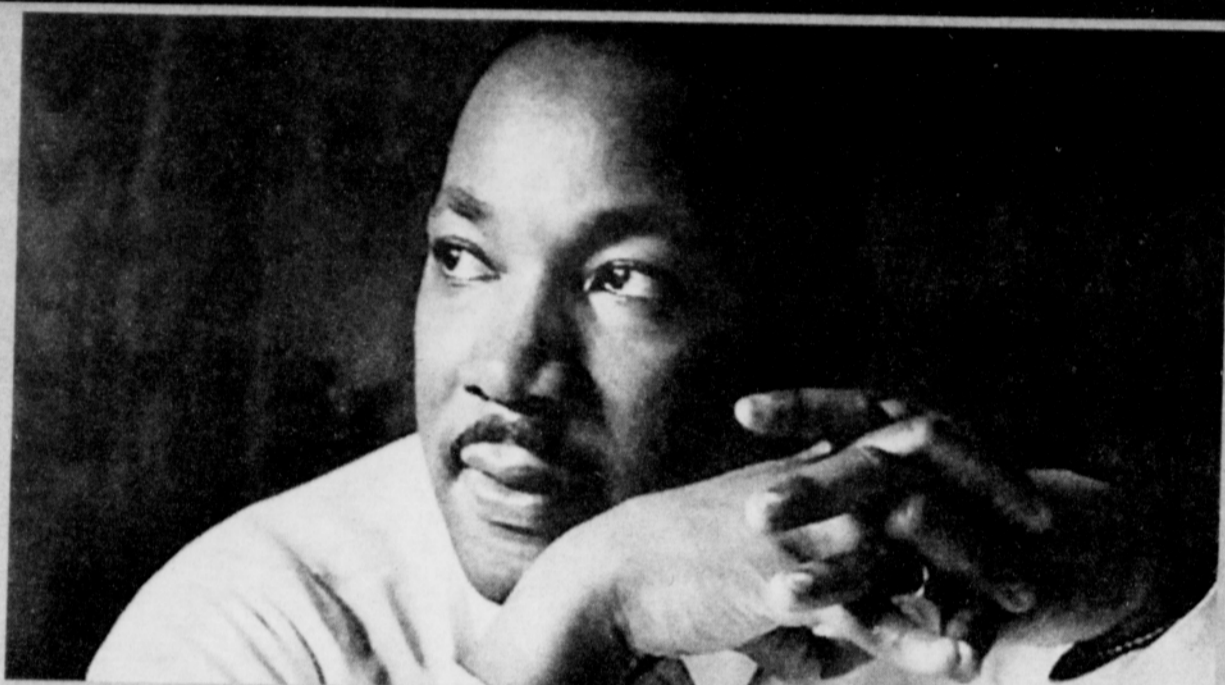

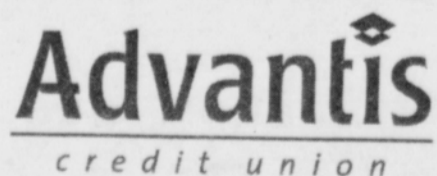

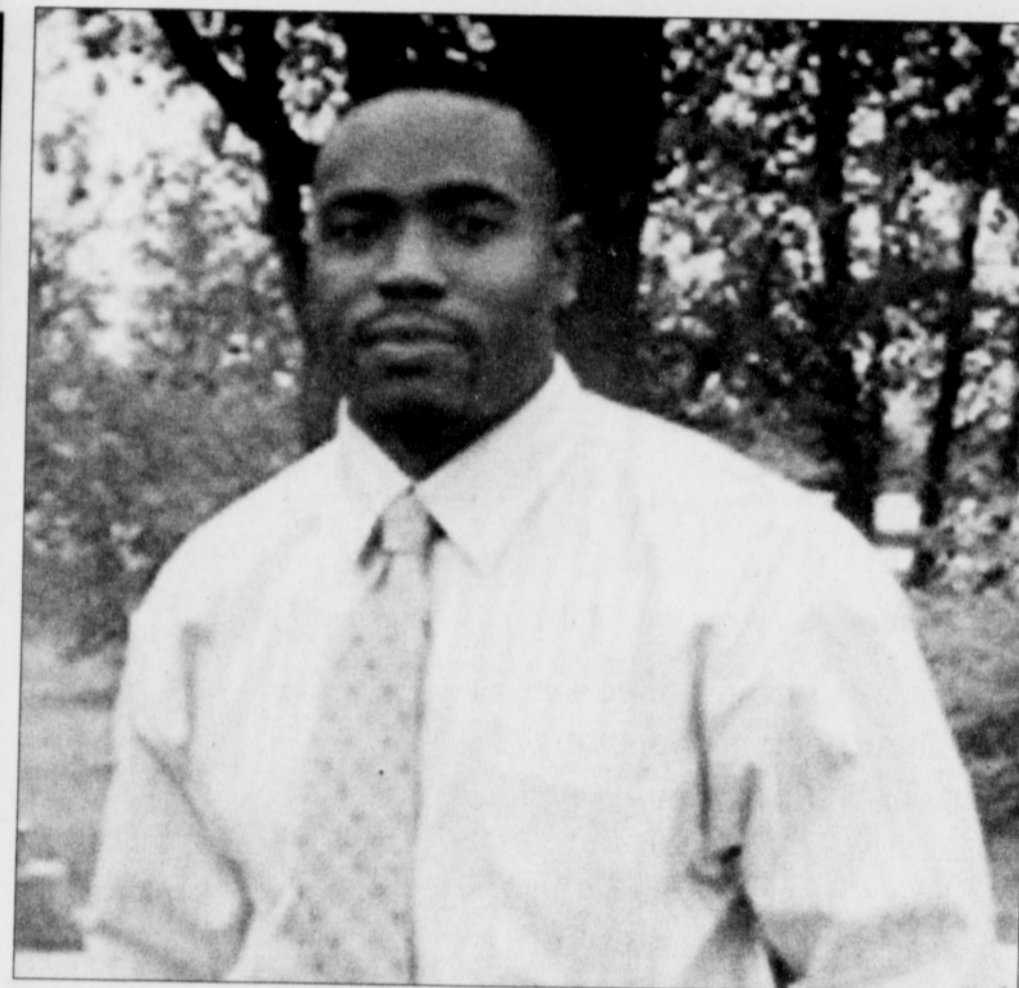

The next day on Tuesday, Jan. 22, Dr. King's legacy will
