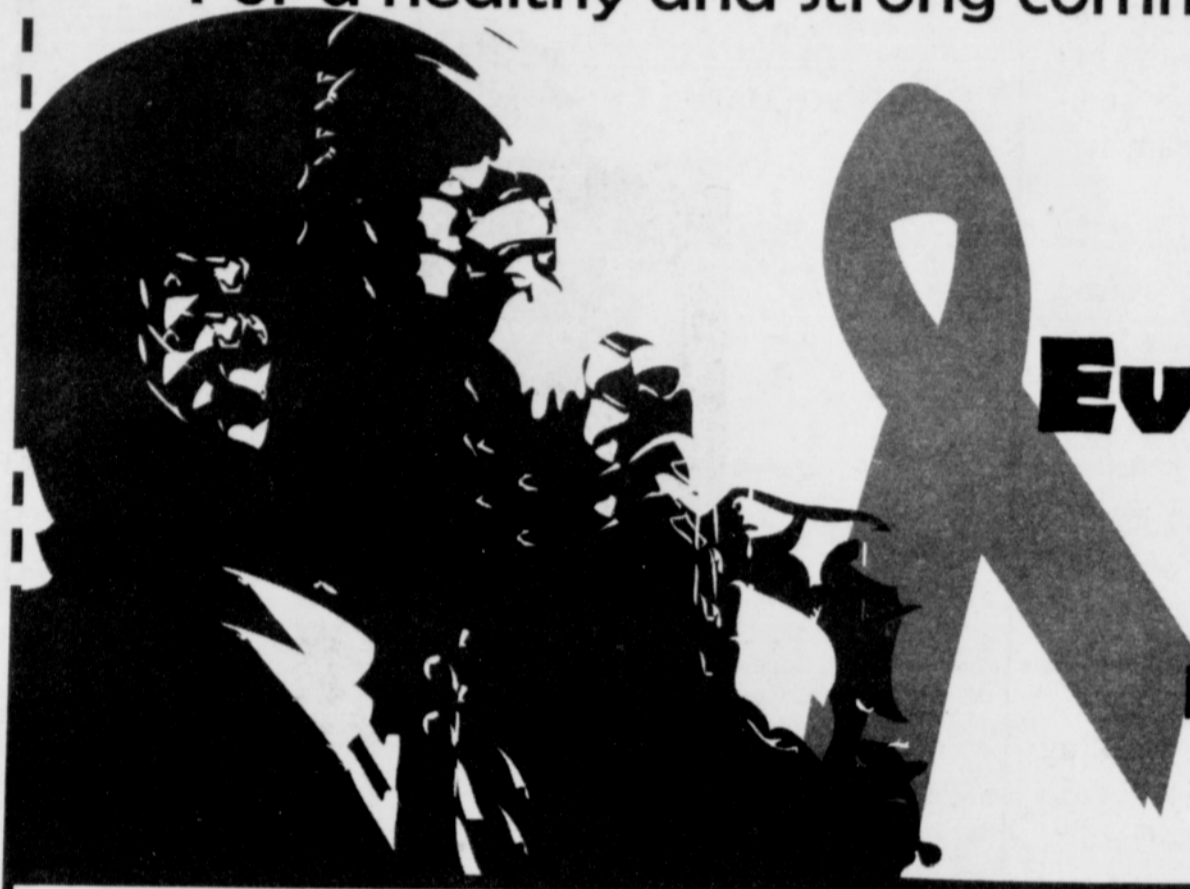
## Fees Waived for MLK Holiday

The public is invited to use federal recreation day-use sites without any fees on the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday, Monday, Jan. 21, in honor of the legacy of the civil rights leader and his work.

The Obama administration fee waiver applies to federal recreation lands managed by the U.S. Forest Service, as well as by the National Park Service, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Bureau of Land Management and Bureau of Reclamation.

It does not apply to SnoParks although they might be located on national public lands. The SnoPark permit program is sponsored by the states of Oregon and Washington. Those using SnoParks that day must have SnoPark permits.
