

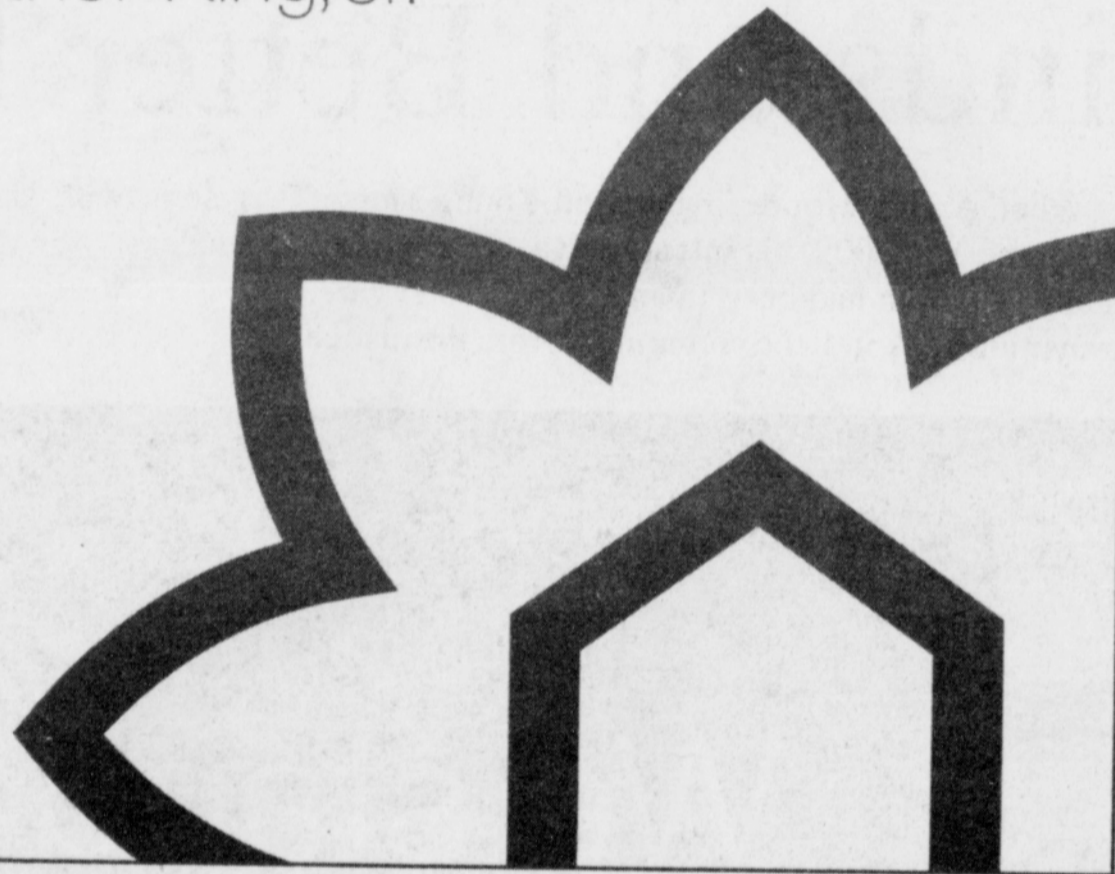

## TriMet Adjusts Schedules for MLK Holiday

TriMet will modify its normal holiday schedule for the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday on Monday, Jan. 21.

The changes match ridership demand as more people use mass transit on the MLK holiday than any other holiday of the year, TriMet officials said.

MAX light-rail and WES commuter rail will run on regular weekday schedules as will 45 heavily-traveled bus lines. But 10 bus routes will run on Saturday schedules and 24 lines will be canceled, including the five lines serving Marquam Hill.

Buses running on Saturday schedules are Lines 48, 52, 62, 71, 72, 75, 76, 77, 78 and 88. Canceled bus routes are Lines 1, 18, 28, 29, 34, 36, 37, 38, 39, 43, 47, 50, 51, 53, 55, 59, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 68, 84 and 99. For more information, visit [trimet.org](http://trimet.org).
