(AP)-- Tina Turner is on her way to becoming a Swiss citizen.

The American rock diva has lived in the Zurich suburb of Kuesnacht since the mid-1990s. The local Zuerichsee-Zeitung newspaper said on its website the local council announced its decision to grant the

73-year-old Turner citizenship in an official notice published in Friday's edition.

The decision still requires formal approval from cantonal (state) and federal authorities.

Portland's dance series White Bird Uncaged presents the eagerly awaited return of Montreal's Compagnie Marie Chouinard, Thursday, Jan. 31 through Saturday, Feb. 2 at Portland State University's Lincoln Hall.

The program features Chouinard's acclaimed treatment of two iconic works, the Rite of Spring, set to Igor Stravinsky's landmark score Le Sacre du Printemps, and Prelude to an Afternoon of a Faun, set to Claude Debussy's Prélude à l'après-midi d'un faune.

The company last appeared with White Bird in

October 2005. Marie Chouinard explores the poetics of the body in immediate and provocative ways with dance that critics hail as both "savage and infinitely refined."

The Village Voice calls her choreography "powerful . . . honoring the impetuosity of the music and exulting in a frenzy of life-affirming and arrestingly original dance."
