Founded in 1914, NAACP Branch 1120 is the oldest continuously chartered chapter of the national organization west of the Mississippi.

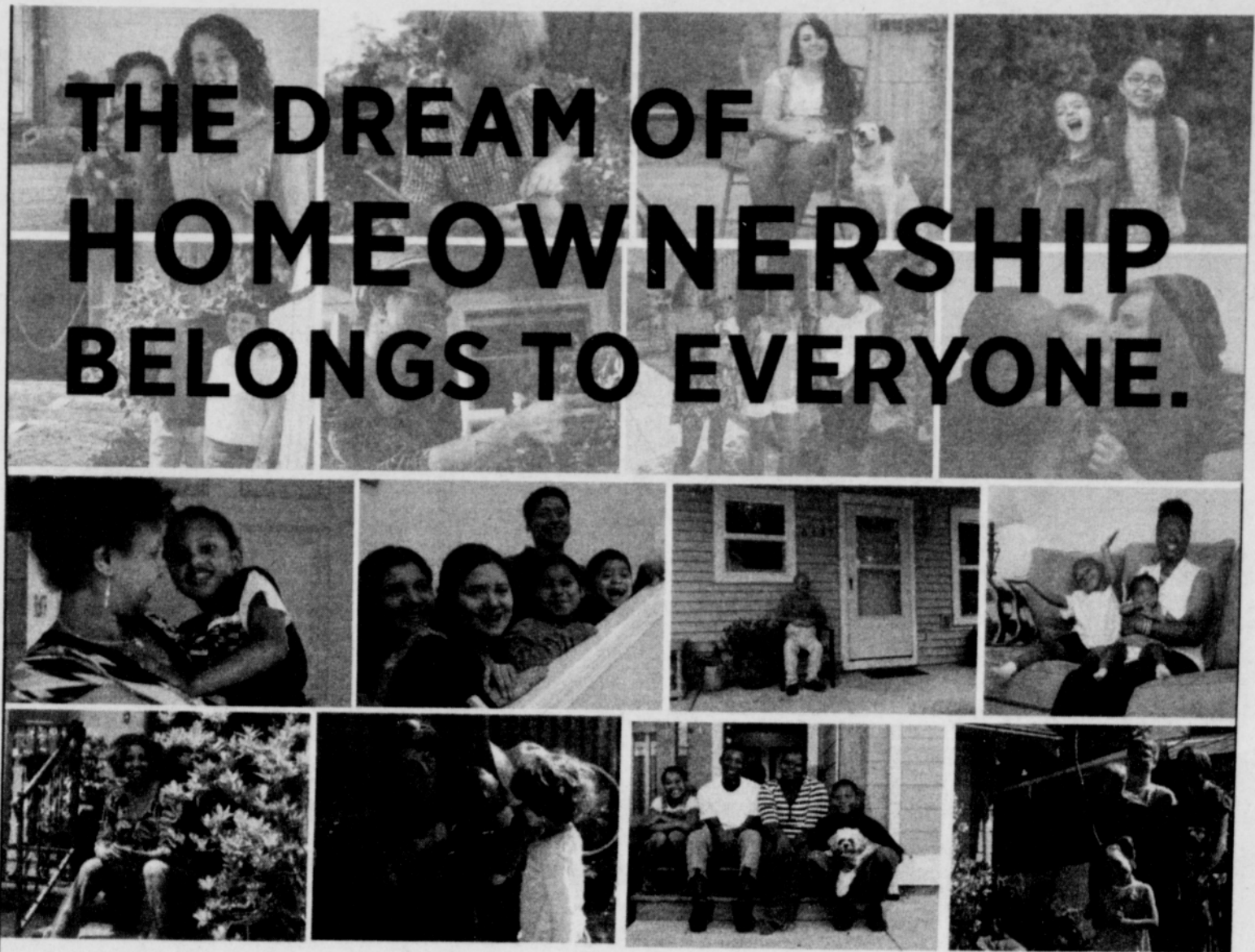

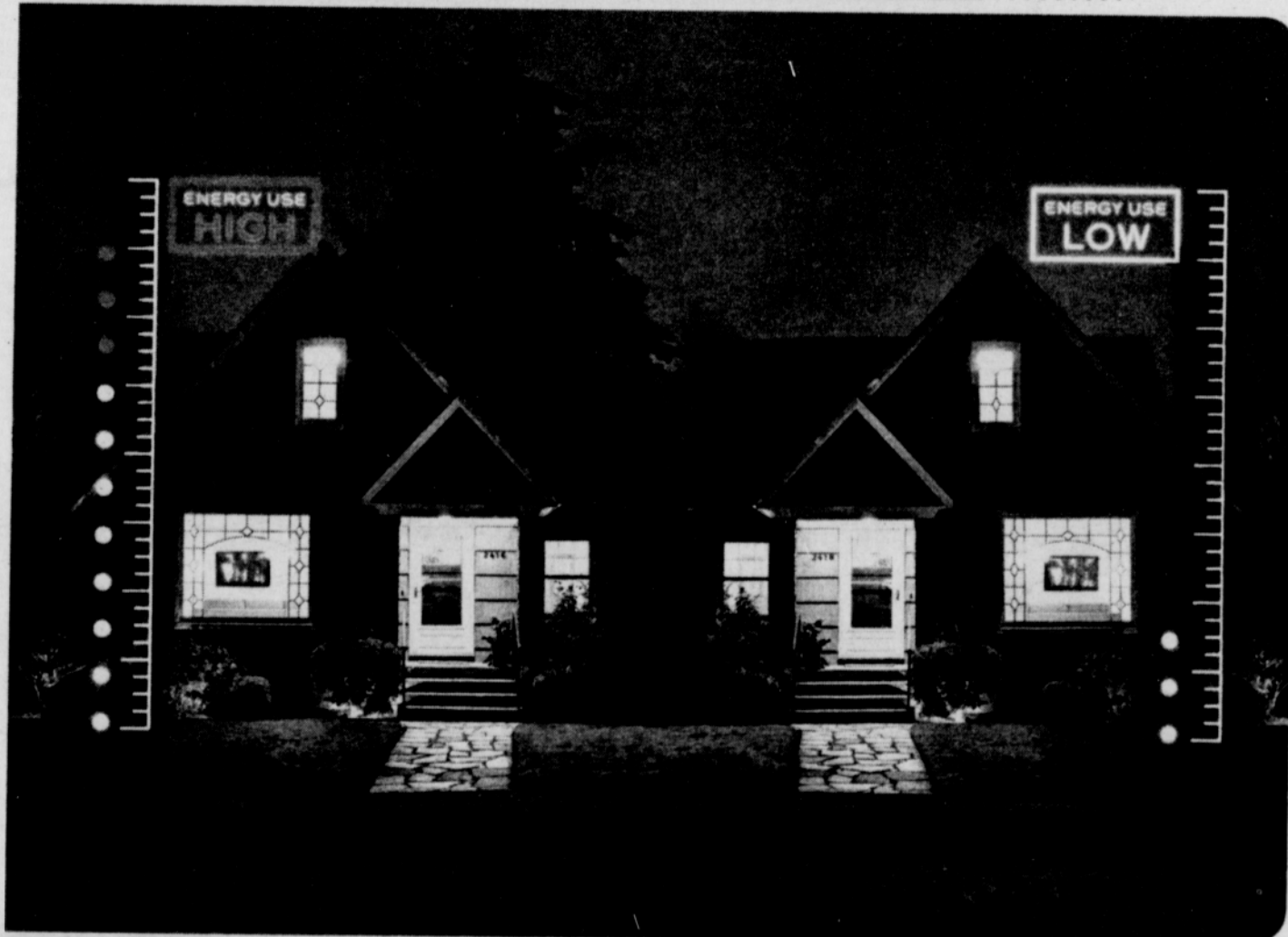
