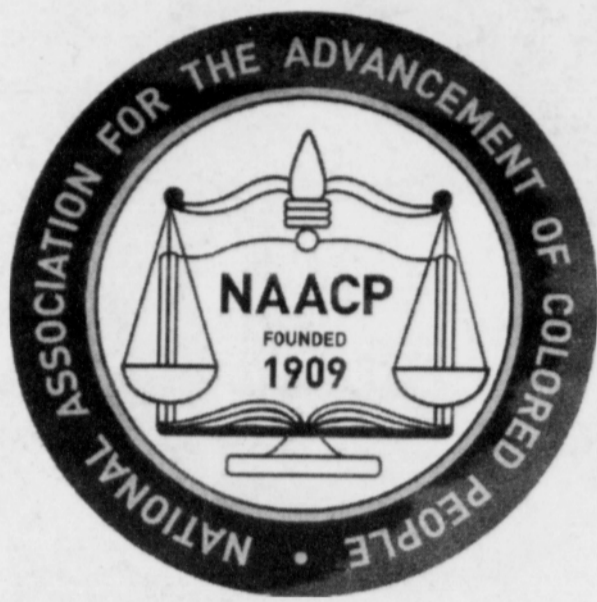

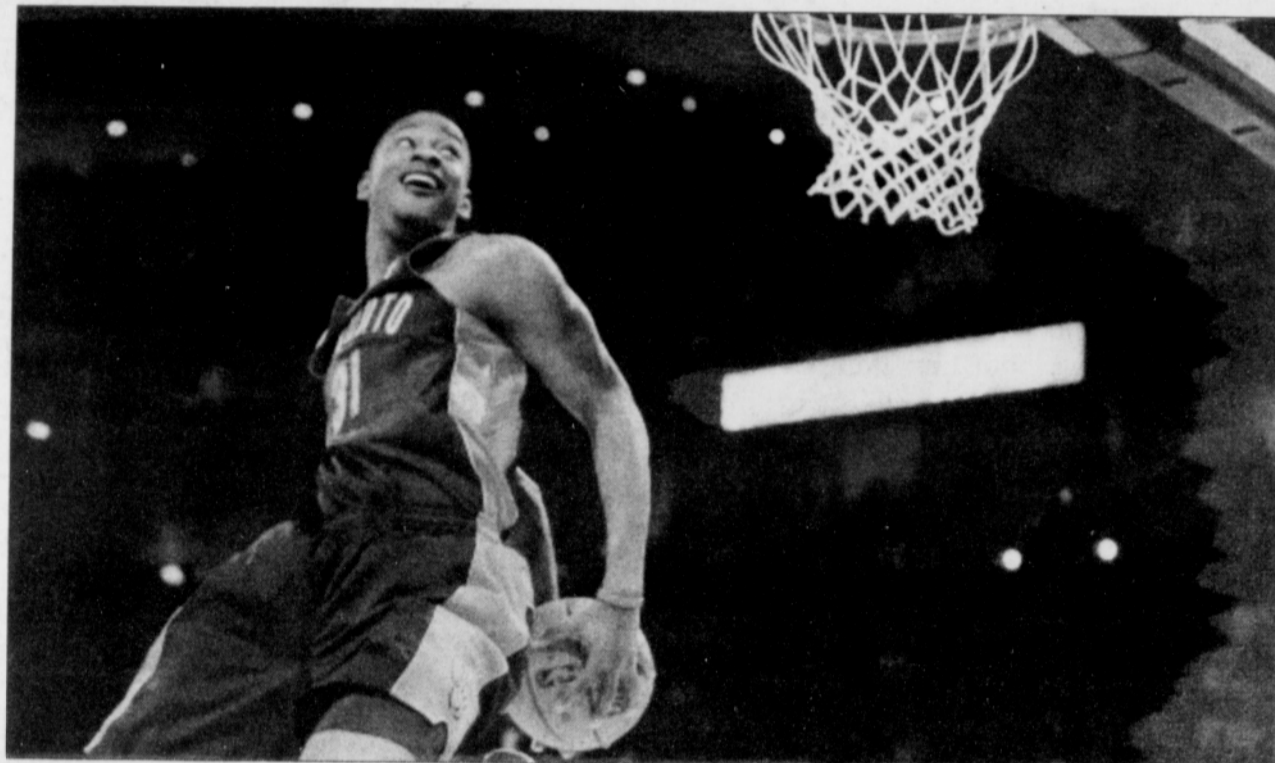

Former Jefferson player hammers NBA contest

(AP)-- Terrence Ross, the former Jefferson High School standout, had to settle his nerves at the start of the NBA All-Star dunk contest. By the end, he was calming down a ball boy he needed as a prop for his winning slam.

The 6-foot-6 Toronto rookie leap-

frogged Michael Costolo, whipped the ball between his legs and hammered home a one-handed dunk to beat defending champion Jeremy Evans in the climax to All-Star Saturday in Houston.

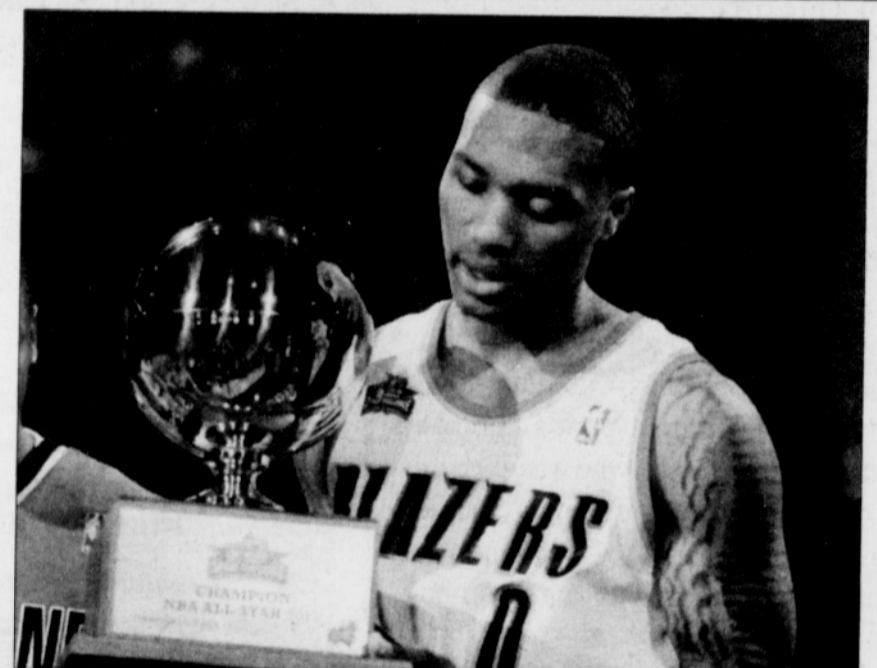
"I told him the day before that I was going to jump over him, but I
