Patrick Lamb to perform with Oregon Symphony

Portland's Billboard charting and acclaimed funk, soul, R&B, and Jazz musician and songwriter Patrick Lamb will perform with the Oregon Symphony, conducted by Jeff Tyzik, for a night of Jazz on Friday, April 6 at 7:30 p.m. and Saturday, April 7 at 3 p.m. at the Arlene Schnitzer Concert Hall, 1037 S.W. Broadway.

Lamb's latest single, a tribute to American Jazz saxophonist Maceo Parker, "Maceo!" is currently #2 on Billboard and is playing on radio stations across the U.S. His other Billboard charting singles are "Sweet Tea" and "Get Wid It".

"Maceo!" is co-produced by American Grammy Award nominated keyboardist, composer and producer Jeff Lorber (The Jeff Lorber Fusion) and is available for purchase on iTunes, CD Baby, Amazon and record stores internationally.

"I've always been a fan of the Oregon Symphony," said Lamb, "To perform with them is a great milestone in my professional musical career and I cordially invite you all to come and join us when we bring Jazz to the Arlene Schnitzer Concert Hall."
