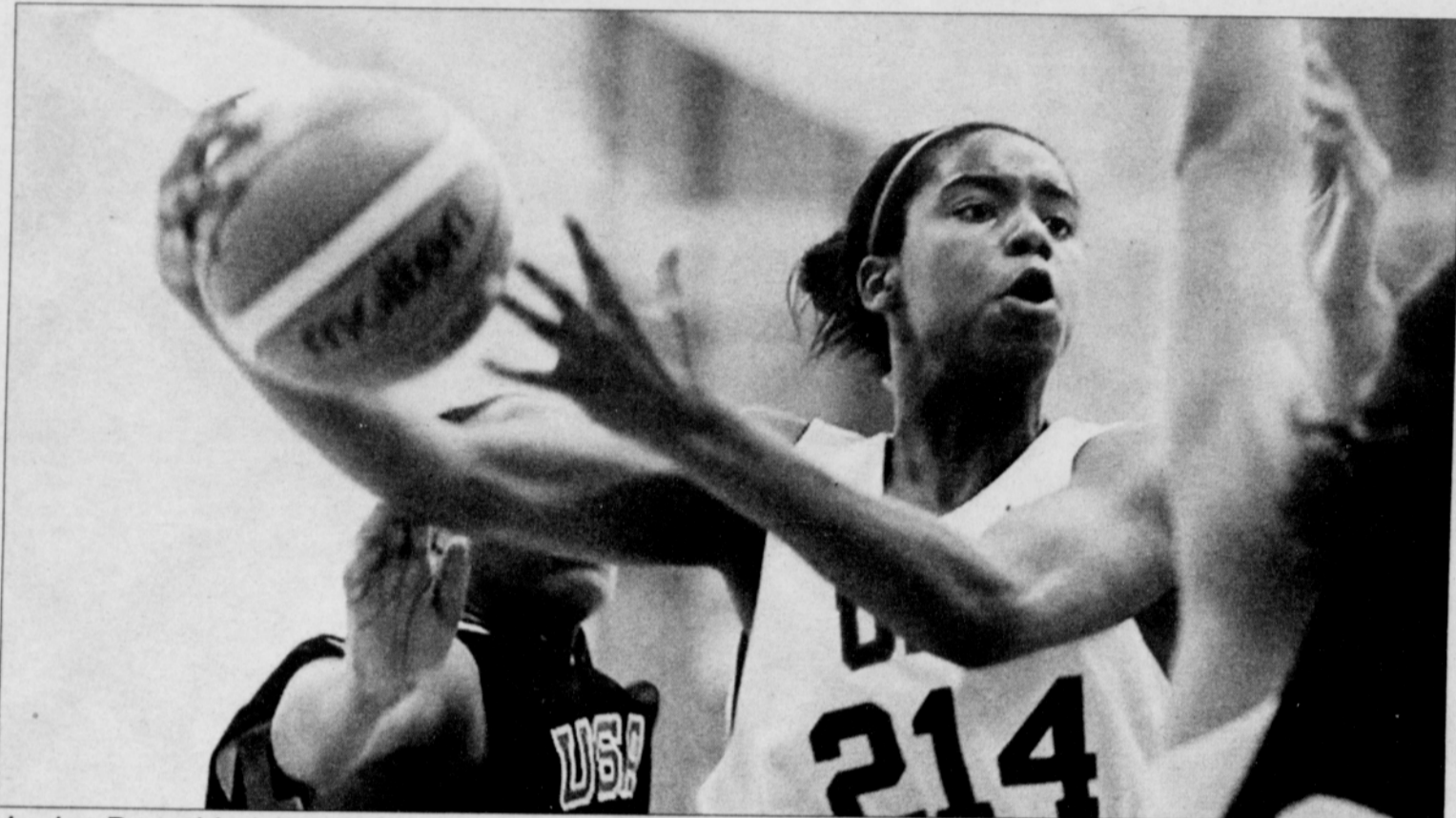

## Basketball Stars are All-Americans

After powering their high school's first-ever girls basketball state championship, Central Catholic seniors Kailee Johnson and Jordan Reynolds have been invited to compete in the 2013 McDonald's High School All-American Game, Wednesday, April 3 in

Chicago.

The all-star game consists of the top high-school players from the United States and Canada, divided into west and east coast teams.

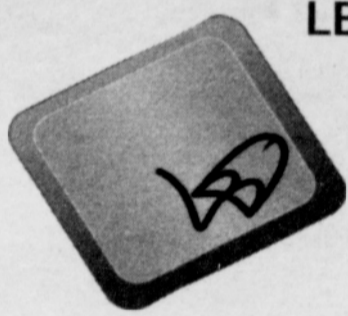
Johnson was also voted Oregon's 6A Player

of the Year this week by coaches in the state.

The Stanford-bound forward averaged 18.1 points, 10.5 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 1.9 block shots this season, while shooting 63.5 percent and making 62.6 percent of her free throws.

During Central Catholic's recent 57-38 state championship victory over South Medford, Johnson scored 22 points and a record 12 rebounds, while Reynolds, a forward and Tennessee signee, scored 15 points and had 11 boards.
