Neighbors Pitch a Battle -- Portland Center Stage's production of Bruce Norris' Clybourne Park continues Tuesday through Sunday through May 5 at Portland Center Stage. A white community in 1950s Chicago splinters over the black family about to move in. Fast forward to our present day, the same house represents very different demographics, and neighborhood values and tensions. Hilarious and horrifying neighbors pitch a battle over territory and legacy that forces us to consider how far our ideas about race have evolved—or not.
