Many community members may not know that in mid-October of 2012, the Eliot E-Mat Café, owned and operated by James and Leanner Posey was tragically damaged by water caused by faulty overhead plumbing in their leased spaced at 2808 Dr. Martin Luther King Blvd (the old Standard Dairy building in the Eliot neighborhood on the corner of NE Stanton and MLK). Since January 2013, the business has re-opened with limited hours. As one of the few African American owned retail businesses in the Portland community, the damage was devastating and caused the owners to consider permanently closing the business that marks its 13 year anniversary May 1, 2013.
