'Bring Ivancie Home'

Portland woman disappears during Hawaii celebration

A trip with her boyfriend and close friend has taken a mysterious twist for a local woman and Jefferson High School graduate Ivance "Ivy" Harris. She went missing last Thursday during a trip to Honolulu, Hawaii that was supposed to be in celebration of her 29th birthday.

The party has quickly turned to panic as family, friends, and police frantically look for clues into her disappearance. Harris was last seen at 2:15 a.m. on May 16 talking to an unknown man outside a bar in Waikiki called Kelley O'Neil's.

Sister Holley Watson has started a Facebook page for Harris called, "BRING Ivance Home".

She was last seen wearing a red-orange, long sleeve sweater and long blue denim pants and is described by Honolulu Police Department as African-American, 5 feet 3 inches tall, and weighing 125 pounds.
