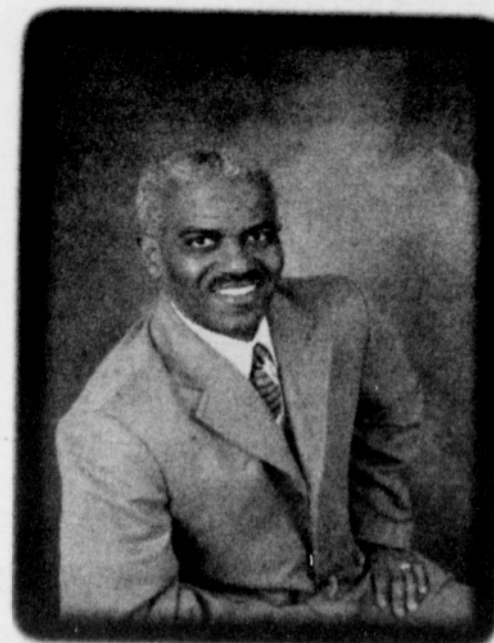


Baby Elephant's Own Doughnut
