PDX Jazz at Jimmy Mak's

The Jimmy Greene Quartet featuring George Colligan, Chris Higgins, and Matt Jorgensen presented by PDX Jazz @ Jimmy Mak's will appear Monday, July 15 at 7:30 p.m.

Greene, who is taking part in the PSU Summer Jazz Camp, will be joined by a collection of Portland's top jazz musicians for a show that will benefit the My Sandy Hook Family Fund to directly support the families of the 26 who were killed in the Connecticut school shooting last December.

Greene's daughter, Ana, was one of the 26 victims of the Sandy Hook

shooting.

While in high school, Jimmy Greene had the good fortune of learning first hand from one of the all time greats, Jackie McLean. Greene adapted much of McLean's advanced alto technique to the tenor. Of course, there's some Coltrane and Rollins to be found in his sound, too, but the end result is a style that's mainstream bop, albeit in his own way.

Greene is also an accomplished composer, drawing on experience and collaborations with Horace Silver, Tom Harrell, Avishai Cohen, and Freddie Hubbard.

'Weird Al' Boosts Concert Series

Inatowplastered with "Keep Portland Weird" bumperstickers — and parodies of "Keep Portland Weird" bumperstickers — it figures that "Weird Al" Yankovic should receive a warm welcome. Tickets have almost sold out for the master parodist's Thursday, July 18 show, part of the Oregon Zoo's 2013 summer concert series.

Yankovic — who has sold more than 12 million records over the years — first rose to fame during the 1980s heyday of MTV, with songs and videos spoofing some of that era's biggest stars.

with witty pokes at grunge ("Smells Like Nirvana"), hip-hop (the platinum-selling "White and Nerdy") and just about everything else in the pop culture landscape.

LeAnn Rimes, Indigo Girls, Trombone Shorty, Lee Brice, Los Lobos, Chris Isaak, the Doobie Brothers and more.
