Allen Temple hosts meeting to make plans

The Albina Ministerial Alliance Coalition for Justice and Police Reform is hosting a community meeting to organize a march and rally commemorating the historic 1963 March on Washington to be held on Saturday, Aug. 24 in Portland.

All interested organizations and individuals are invited to help in the planning and implementation of this historic opportunity. The meeting will be held on Thursday, July 18 at 6:30 p.m. at Allen Rev. Leroy Haynes Temple Church, 4236 N.E. Eighth Ave.

The March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom took place in Washington, D.C. on Aug. 28, 1963. Attended by some 250,000 people, it was the largest demonstration ever seen in the nation's capital, and one of the first to have extensive television coverage.

1963 was noted for racial unrest and civil rights demonstrations. Nationwide outrage was sparked by media coverage of police actions in Birmingham, Ala., where attack dogs and fire hoses were turned against

protestors, many of whom were in their early teens or younger. Martin Luther King, Jr., was arrested and jailed during these protests, writing his famous "Letter from Birmingham City Jail," which advocates civil disobedience against unjust

50 years later the issues of jobs, justice and equality for African Americans has not been realized. With the recent U.S. Supreme Court ruling gutting Section 4 of the Voting Rights Act and the acquittal of neighborhood watch volunteer in the

death of an unarmed teenager Trayvon Martin, we know there is a lot of work still to be done.


