

# MLK Dream Run Nears

The second annual MLK Dream Run/Walk aimed at promoting economic development and health and wellness in the Soul of Portland, will be held Sunday Aug. 4.

An additional component, the MLK Dream Run Health and Ex-boutique is being planned prior to race on Saturday, Aug. 3. This event will consist of small business booth space, health awareness components, food and entertainment.

Both events are sponsored by the North/Northeast Business Association and will help raise funds

for several community organizations including the NNEBA Fellows Program, a youth entrepreneurial/career leadership project, and the North by Northeast Community Health Clinic which provides free and low-cost health care to needy families.

Last year's race produced nearly 700 diverse participants from 17 Oregon cities and five states made up of runners, volunteers and spectators, who came together in the name of health, wealth and the honoring of Dr.

Martin Luther King's legacy.

The annual race features three events—a 5 kilometer walk and run, a 10K run and the 15k Geoff Hollister Tribute competitive race—along a USA Track & Field sanctioned & certified race course throughout the neighborhoods of Humboldt, King, Piedmont, Woodlawn, Boise, Eliot, Vernon, Grant Park, Sabin, Woodlawn and Irvington.

The goal of the running event is to reintroduce Portland residents and visitors to the revitalized N/NE community by bringing businesses and neighborhoods together providing economic stimulus to an area rich in multicultural history.

Multnomah County Board Chairman Jeff Cogan is admitting to an affair

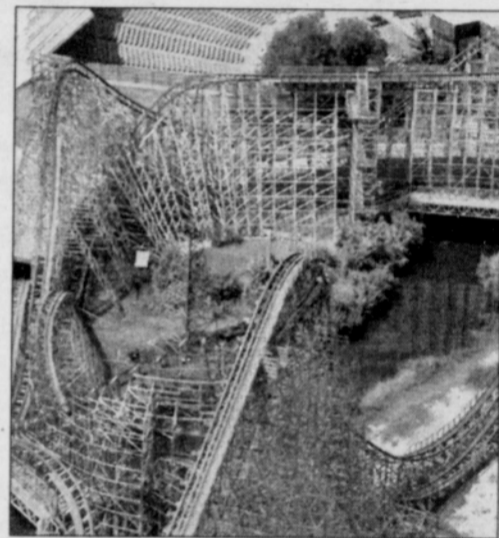
with a subordinate in the county's Health Department. The relationship is also documented in emails between the two that were released to the public.
