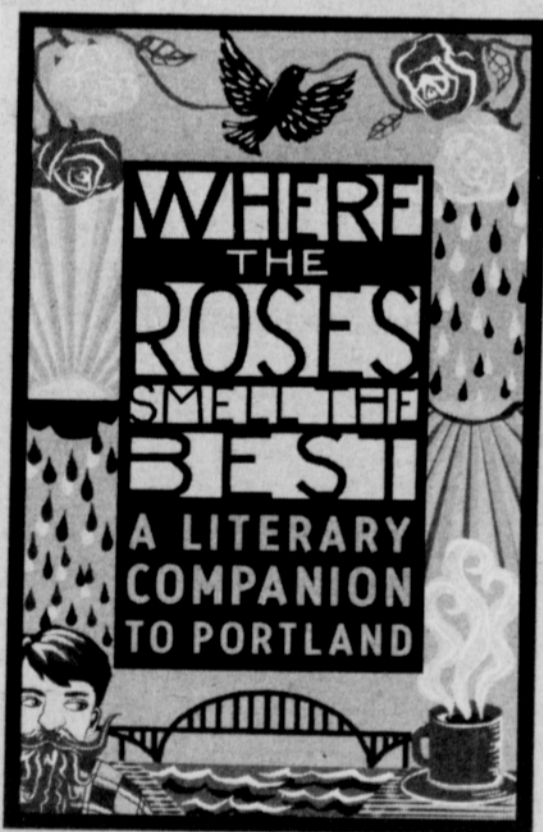

Student-Led Book Published



Roosevelt High School in north Portland is celebrating a year of hard work by students and volunteers as it launches its first book. Student-led Unique Ink has published *Where the Roses Smell the Best*, a literary companion to Portland that is filled with short stories, vignettes, and poems about the places, people, and lifestyles of Portland.

The book includes work from Roosevelt students alongside local authors such as Brian Doyle, Kim Stafford, Steve Duin, Renee Mitchell and Paulann Petersen.

Unique Ink is a student-staffed publisher based out of Roosevelt High School's Writing and Publishing Center that was established in 2012.
