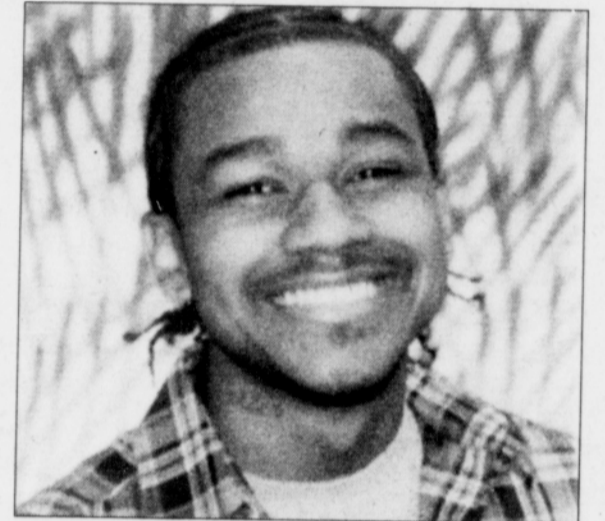
In Loving Memory
