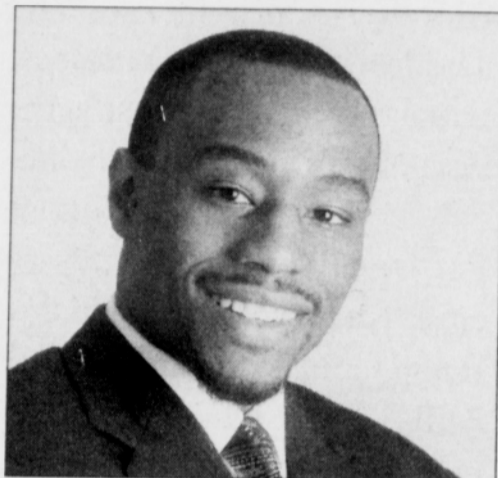
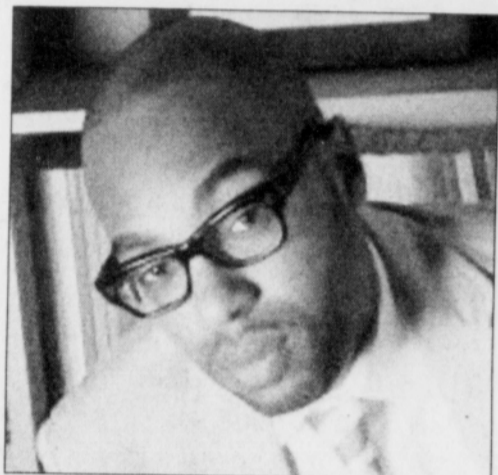

Exploring Hip-Hop Culture

Guest scholars front diversity lecture series

A series of free and open to the public lectures next month at Warner Pacific College will explore the hip hop culture with three prominent authors and scholars.

"It's Bigger than Hip-Hop: Community, Education, and Spiritual-

ity" will be held at McGuire Auditorium on the College's Mt. Tabor campus. The three-part event is part of the college's second annual Diversity Lecture Series.

Oregon Musical Hall Honors

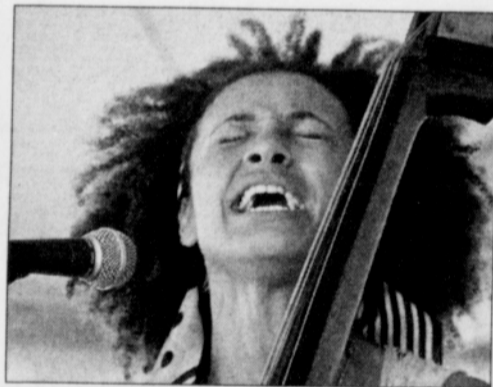

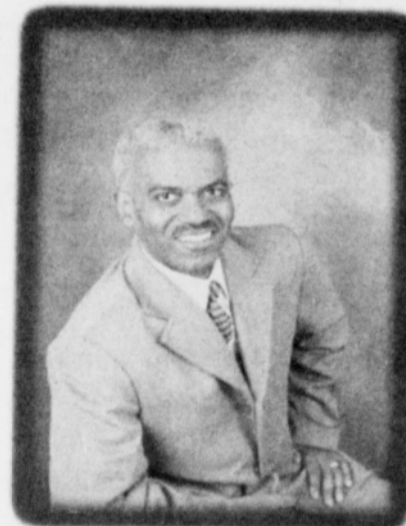
