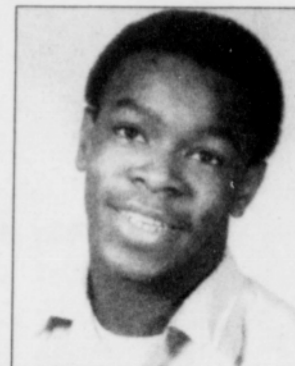


Obituaries
