There will be an opportunity for

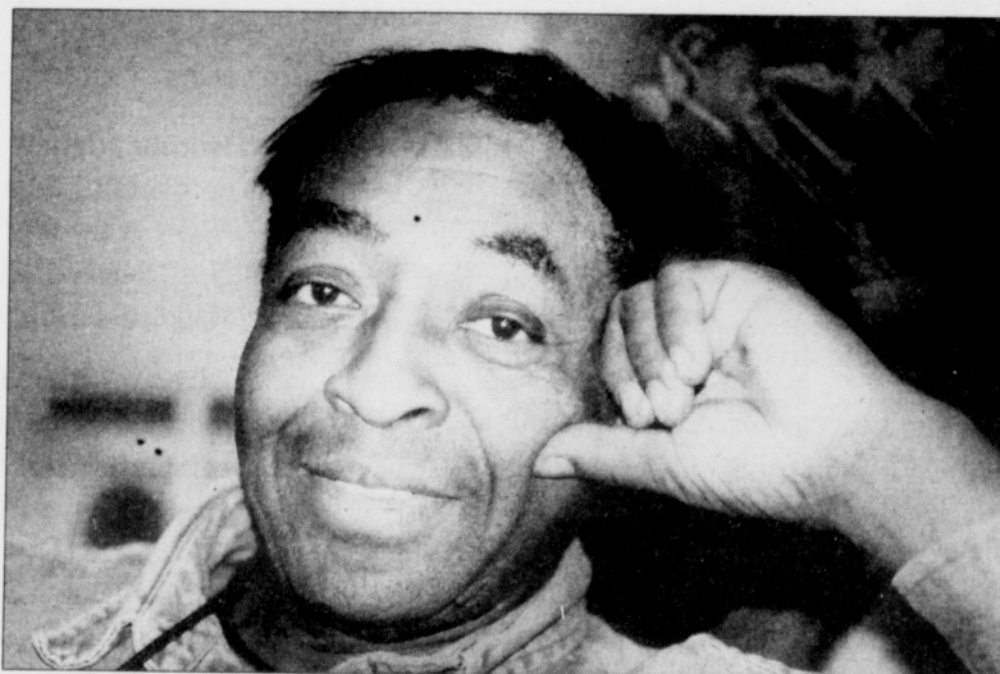
