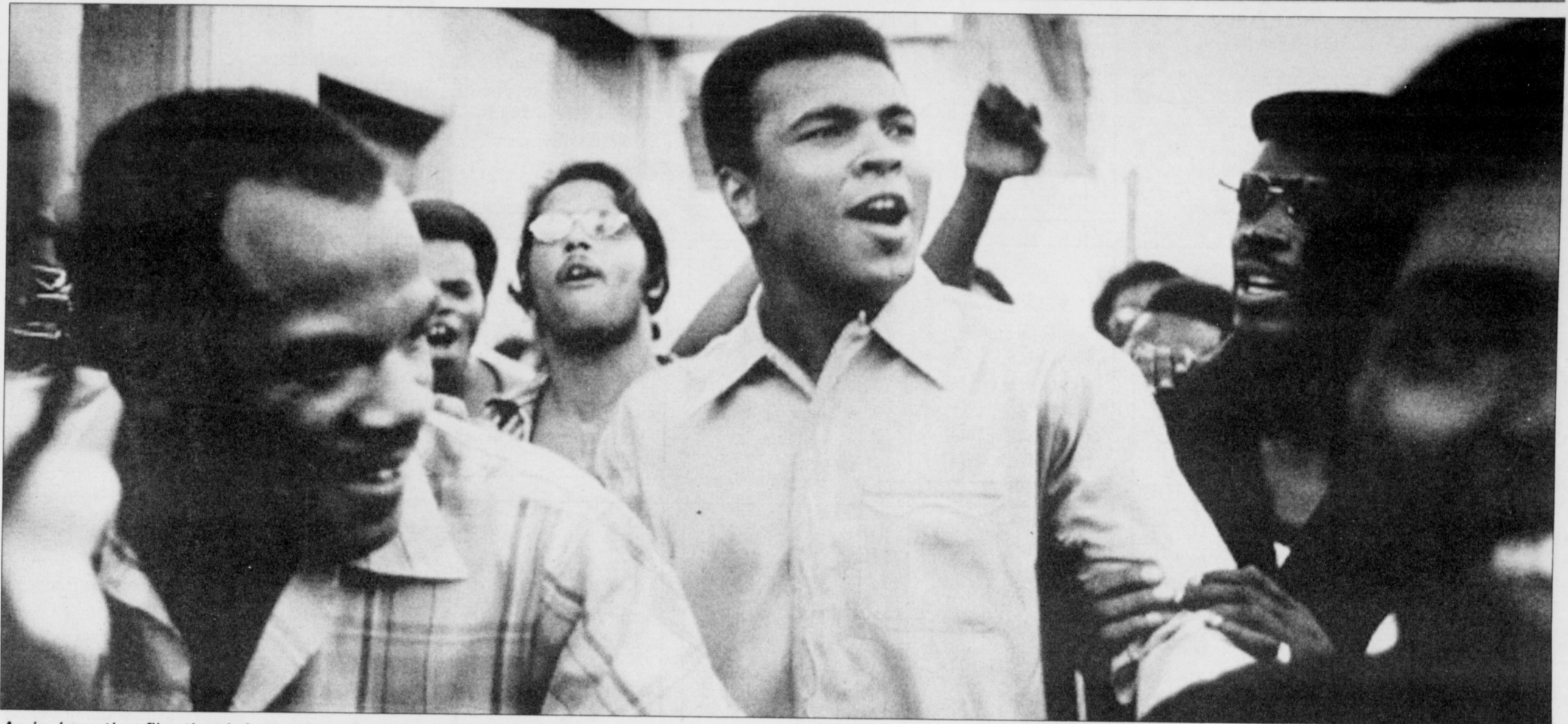

An invigorating film that brings a long-forgotten controversy to life, *The Trials of Muhammad Ali* comes to The Northwest Film Center on Wednesday, Oct. 9.

The Trials of Muhammad Ali

Cassius Clay's transformation to Muhammad Ali—his conversion to Islam and refusal to serve in the Vietnam War—were defining acts of personal conscience

in the 1960s, a riveting one-man challenge to institutional racism, religious intolerance, and a failed justice system.

Banned from his livelihood

and convicted of a felony with a five-year prison sentence, Ali was forced to spend four years fighting his way to the Supreme Court.

Bill Siegel's film, rich with archival footage and interviews, examines Ali's complicated relationships with the key voices of the era and the impact of his actions on a culture that still struggles with the issues of race, identity, faith, and the justice he

stood for.

The documentary plays Wednesday, Oct. 9 at Whitsell Auditorium, located in the Portland Art Museum. Admission is \$9 general and \$8 for students and seniors. For more information, visit nwfilm.org.
