Haunting Dive into the Underworld

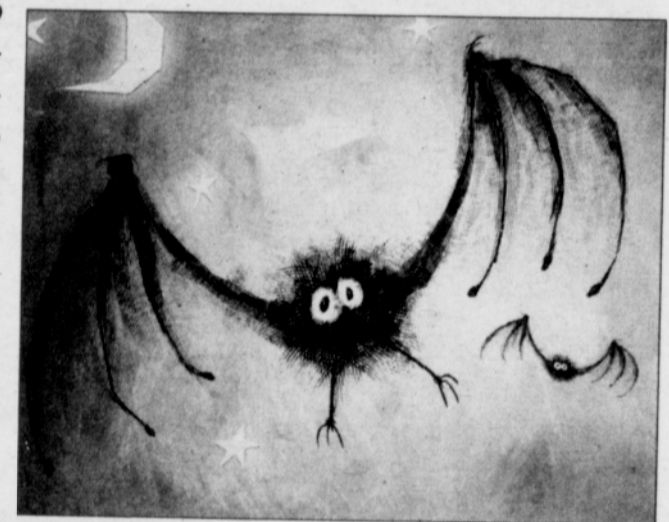
